CONSIDERED IN THE PAST AS AMONG THE RURAL BARANGAYS OF BACOLOD CITY, IT WAS SAID THAT ALIJIS ORIGINS NAMES CAME FROM AGIHIS, AFTER AN ABUNDANT FRESH WATER SHELLS FOUND IN ITS RIVERS. THROUGH THE YEARS, HOWEVER, FOLKS TRANSFORMED THE TERM AGIHIS TO ALIJIS.

AND, THRU REPUBLIC ACT NO. 2264 THAT CREATED BARRIOS AND THEIR CHARTERS, UPON PASSAGE OF CITY ORDINANCE NO. 116 SERIES OF 1962 OR AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE BARRIOS OF ALIJIS AND DEFINING ITS BOUNDARIES ( THRU S.P. RES. NO. 262 S. 1962 RESOLUTION APPROVING AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE BARRIOS OF ALIJIS AND DEFINING ITS BOUNDARIES”) INSTITUTIALIZED THE NAME OF THE BARANGAY AS BARANGAY ALIJIS.
