## II. RESPONSIBLE PARENTHOOD-REPRODUCTIVE HEALTH & FAMILY PLANNING

**ABOUT THE SERVICE:** Responsible Parenthood pertains to the well and ability of couples or individuals to respond to the needs and aspirations of the family and children. RP promotes a shared responsibility of the husband and wife to determine and achieve the desired timing, spacing and the number of their children according to their own family life aspirations, taking into account psychological preparedness, health status and their socio-cultural and economic capacities.

Reproductive Health focus on providing an enabling environment for men and women to be informed and to have access to safe, effective, affordable and acceptable methods of Family Planning of their choice, other methods of their choice for regulation of fertility which are not against the law. It also includes providing the right access to appropriate health care services that will enable women to go safely through pregnancy and childbirth and provide couples the best chance of having a healthy infant.

### III. PRE-MARRIAGE COUNSELING

#### ABOUT THE SERVICE:

Presidential Decree 965, the 1987 Family Code, the Local Government Code, and the Responsible Parenthood and Reproductive Health Act (RA 10354) require all contracting parties or would-be-couples applying for a marriage license to attend and participate in a Pre-Marriage Orientation and Counseling session before they are issued such license.
