Brief History of Barangay:

BARANGAY SUM-AG WAS CREATED A PUEBLO IN 1803 BY ALCALDE MAYOR DON MANUEL VALDEVIESO Y MORQUECHO. IT WAS ORIGINALLY KNOWN AS PUEBLO DE SUM-AG AND WAS RANKED BY THE SPANISH GOVERNMENT AS A TOWN COVERING TANGUB, CANSILAYAN, PAHANOCOY, FELISA TALOC, PTA. TAY2, ABUANAN, TABUANAN AND DULAO.

THE COMMUNITY THRIVED ECONOMICALLY BY REASON OF ITS LOCATION AT THE MOUTH OF SUM-AG RIVER.

BARANAGAY SUM-AG IS ONE OF THE OLDEST BARANGAYS (FORMERLY CALLED BARRIO) IN THE WHOLE ISLAND OF NEGROS AND THE OLDEST IN THE CITY OF BACOLOD. IT WAS FOUNDED IN THE YEAR 1780. IN NOVEMBER 1803 ALCALDE MAYOR, DON MANUEL VALDEVIESO MADE IT A PUEBLO OR A REGULAR TOWN COVERING TANGUB, CANSILAYAN, PAHANOCOY, TALOC, PTA. TAYTAY, ABUANAN, TABUANAN AND DULAO.

WHEN A PETITION FOR THE CREATION OF THE MUNICIPALITIES OF MURCIA, BAGO AND BACOLOD, IN 1902, IT REVERTED BACK TO ITS' BARRIO STATUS.

IN 1902, IT WAS REDUCED AS A BARRIO OF BACOLOD RETAINING SOME OF ITS TERRITOTRIAL JURISDICTION, WHILE TALOC, TABUANAN AND DULAO WERE GIVEN TO BAGO AND CANSILAYAN WAS MADE PART OF MURCIA.

SUM-AG NOW A BARRIO INCLUDED PAHANOCOY,FELISA, CABUG AND PTA. TAYTAY; HOWEVER, AS A PARISH OF BACOLOD SUM-AG HAS RETAINED ITS ECCLESIASTICAL JURISDICTION OVER ABUANAN, DULAO,TALOC AND TABUANAN.

DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT

The Sum-ag Barangay Council thru a Barangay Resolution has created the Barangay Sum-ag Rescue Unit (BASRU) in 1999. It has an office and quarters for the crew and driver of ambulance. It is well equipped and responds any emergency in the Barangay on a 24/7 basis.

COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY

The market of those doing business in Barangay Sum-ag Comprise not only of Sum-aganons but of the residents of neighboring and adjacent barangay like Pta. taytay in the West, Pahanocoy in the North, Cabug in the North East, Taloc in the South, and in the West Barangay Tabunan, Dulao, Abuanan and Atipuluhan. This is perhaps the reason why commerce in Barangay Sum-ag is at its fast growing pace.

A clear indication to prove this is the entry of big chain of outlets in this Barangay such as the 7-11 Chain, Munsterific, Fair Mart, Merci, Mercury and Negros Grace. The Lending and Pawnshop Industry are racing to find Commercial spaces for rent to open a branch in Barangay Sumag such as the Cebuana Lhuillier, Villa Rica, Palawan and Maria Gracia, R.D. Pawnshop and R.A Financial Services. In the case of M. Lhuillier, it has two branches here. This is

definitely the reason why commercial buildings rise left and right in Barangay Sum-ag. Barangay Sum-ag also Boast of the presence of thee soon to be (5) Five Lotto Outlets. There are also six (6) gas station in this barangay.

PROTECTIVE SERVICES

Just recently, the Barangay Council has convened the Peace and Order Council to oversee and monitor the Peace and Order situation of their Barangays. Barangay Sum-ag is considered one of the peaceful Barangays in Bacolod City. In fact, Precinct 9 was awarded Best Police Station of the city last August 16, 2012. We believe that "Prevention is better than cure" so there is an urgent need to prepare for any eventualities like terrorism. We have trained our Barangay Tanods to coordinate and augment our Precinct 9 for any emergencies providing them with bicycles and radio communication system.

The DILG mandates to have an organized, effective, and responsive communitybased structure that will promote and guarantee the welfare, safety, health and good moral environment, and wholesome development of children in the barangay. Thus, the Barangay Council for the protection and participation of children and youth in the barangay level. DILG memorandum Circular No. 2001-121 shall be the basis for organizing the BCPC.

Similarly, the barangay organized the VAWC desk to provide a concern institution that promote and enhance women and children's capacities. This also serves as the institution to protect the rights of women and children.

POWER

With the present electrical connections in Barangay Sum-ag, the Barangay Council believes that Barangay Sum-ag is 99% lighted or powered by CENECO. Private businesses mostly have generators in case of brown outs. The highway area of Sum-ag is lighted by mercury lights maintained by the City and the Barangay roads are lighted by led lights maintained by the Barangay.
