HISTORICAL BACKGROUND

Barangay 11 is one of the forty one barangays which was created by virtue of Presidential Decree, by then President Ferdinand Marcos in 1973. Its progenitor was the infamous citizen's assembly. Barangay 11 is the seat of the San Sebastian Cathedral. Under the able and pro-active leadership of Punong Barangay Runelo B. Cervales and through collaborative efforts of the Members of the Barangay Council as well as with the support of its constituents in the community, Barangay 11 was branded as the "Cathedral of Faith" in the City of Bacolod in 1999.

Barangay 11 was awarded 3rd prize as the cleanest Barangay in 1999. The Barangay was also cited for its participation in the MassKara Street Dance Competition in 2001. It is a mainland barangay within the heart of the city. A small urban Barangay encompassing Rizal, Gatuslao, Galo, Locsin and Burgos Streets. Its territorial boundaries also include the Bacolod Cathedral and La Consolacion College (Main) and a part of the Bacolod Public Plaza.

Public Utility Jeepneys plying the Shopping-Libertad, Erereco, Homesite, Sta. Fe, Banago-Liberta, Bata-Libertad, Mandalagan-Libertad, Tangub, Airport, and Punta-taytay routes pass by the barangay.

A. SOCIAL SECTOR

1. HEALTH

Barangay 11 is in particularly very much concerned with the health and sanitation of its people. It has launched various activities congruent to the health and sanitation of its people. It employed Barangay Nutrition Scholar and Barangay Supplemental Feeding Program, Immunization Program and other activities related to health and nutrition program.

- 3. Neighbor Barangay throw their Garbage at the area of Barangay 11.
- 4. Poor Drainage System along Nueva Street – Gatuslao Street

PROGRAM/PROJECTS:

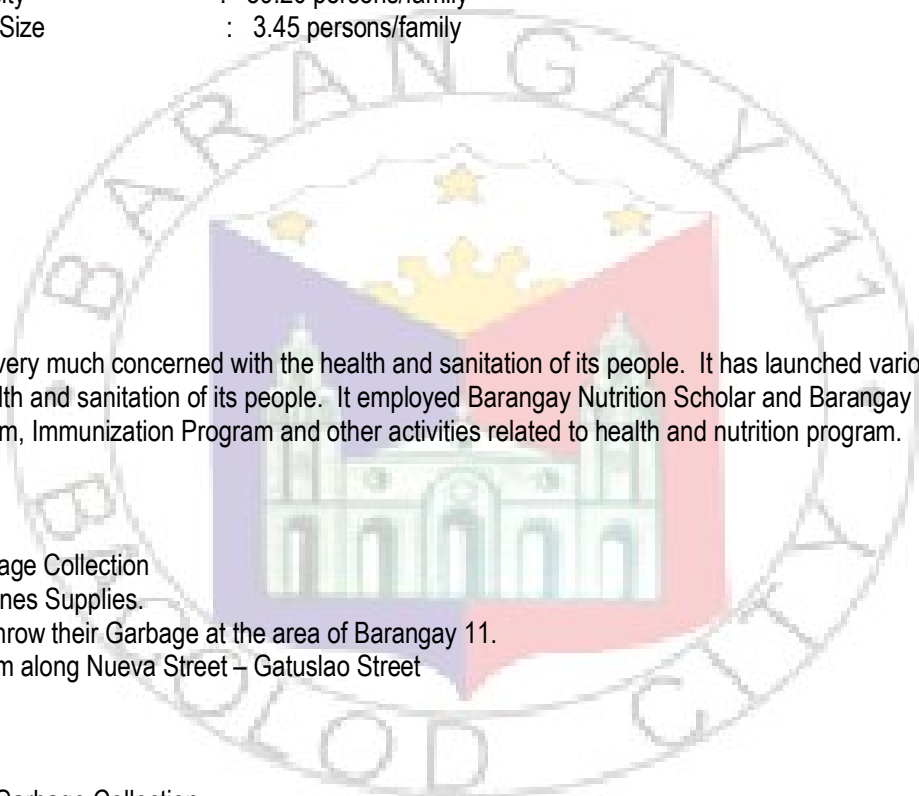
- 1. Utility personnel for Garbage Collection.

2.PROTECTIVE SERVICES

Under the leadership of Punong Barangay Evelyn C. Ta-asan, the council created a Committee on Peace and Order and organized Barangay Pulis Laban sa Krimen (BPK) and Barangay Anti-Drug Abuse to maintain peace and order in the locality.

ISSUES:

- 1. Lack proper training and seminar.
- 2. Lack of Barangay intelligence and Network (BIN).
- 3. Lack of Funds for Barangay Police.



3. EDUCATION

It is for belief that even the poorest of the poor family send their children to the school in order to be literate and become assists to the society rather liability, yet there are still numerous out-of-school youth who failed their studies for the following reasons.

ISSUES:

1. Lack of Parental Guidance and Encouragement.
2. Parent cannot afford to send their children to their school.
3. Lack of children to go to school because of broken family.

3. Some youth are engage with drugs

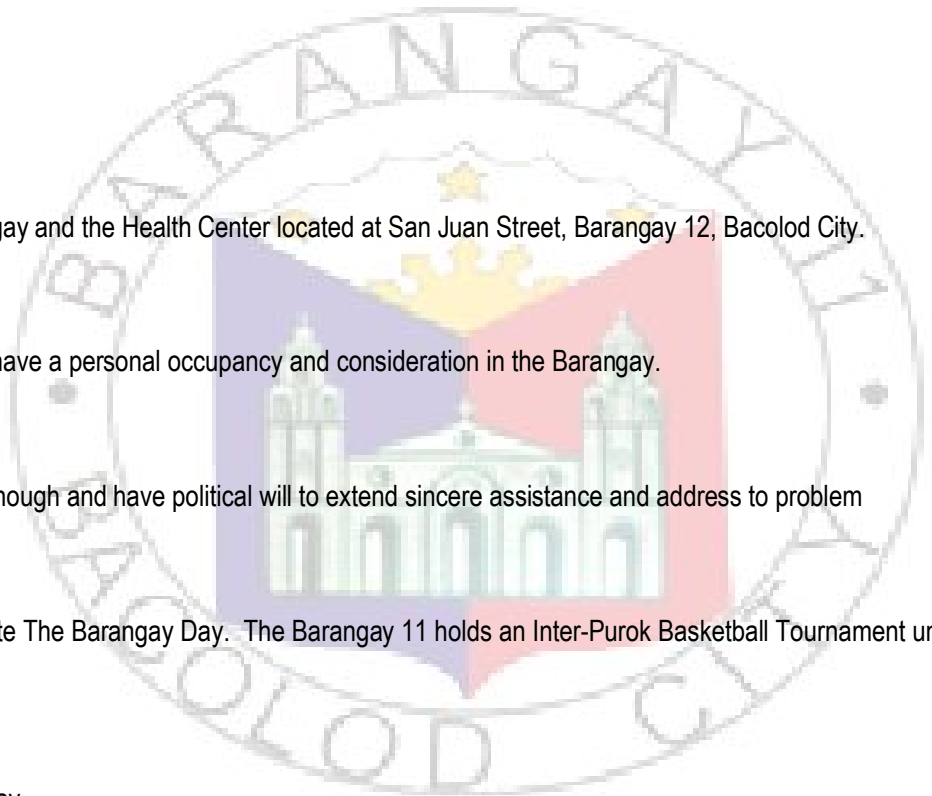
PROGRAMS/PROJECTS:

b. ECONOMIC SECTOR

1. COMMERCE SECTOR

50% of the workers and 46% belongs to gainful workers, 45% is a Business engaged in commercial land distribution of Barangay.



Business engage in commercial area such as Gasoline Station, Laboratory Clinic, Financing, Sari-sari store, Carenderia, Sing Along Bar, School, Printing Press, Xerox Copier, Fruit Vending, Water Station, Hotel and Restauarant.

ISSUES:

1. The Constituent of Barangay complains against the sing along/videoke bar owner that during midnight noise pollution of said establishment.
2. In-active Livelihood Program of Barangay.

1. The Barangay deploy the Barangay Policy within the Commercial are of Barangay to maintain and secure Peace and Order.

ISSUES:

There is no tourist spot in Barangay nor industrial establishment and agricultural facilities.

c. INFRASTRUCTURE

1. TRANSPORTATION

Since Barangay 11 is in the Center of the City. It is possible by PUJ route Shopping Libertad, Banago Libertad, Mandalagan Libertad, Bata Libertad, Sta Fe Central Market, Homesite Central Market, Fortune Towne Central Market and Villamonte Central Market and Vice Versa.

1. Trisikad 20 units of trisikad operating in Barangay
2. Private owned cars.

ISSUES:

1. Cause of heavy, safety of children crossing along Gatuslao Street and Burgos Street.
2. There are some trisikad and jeep operators operated within business permits and drivers without license.

Barangay 11 main source of portable water BACIWA and artesian deep well.

ISSUES:

1. There are some defective regarding meters.
2. Power Supply



Central Negros Cooperative (CENECO) is serving the electric supply of the Barangay.

3. Communication

Barangay 11 is serving by Landline Telephone PLDT, Globe Line, Smart and Sun Cellular proving greater access to communication.

ISSUES:

1. Some residents of the Barangay had no communication facilities.

PROGRAMS/PROJECTS;

1. Barangay Hall has a PLDT Landline for the use of Barangay Constituents in case of emergency.

1. LAND RESOURCE MANAGEMENT

2. AIR QUALITY MANAGEMENT

Barangay 11 has a potable water and safe drinking water. The main water source is Bacolod City Water District (BACIWA). The other source of water for household needs is artesian well.

ISSUES:

1. Some of the artesian well in Barangay is not functioning

PROGRAMS/PROJECTS

1. Thru the effort of the Barangay Council and with the help of the City to install more artesian well in the barangay.

4.SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT

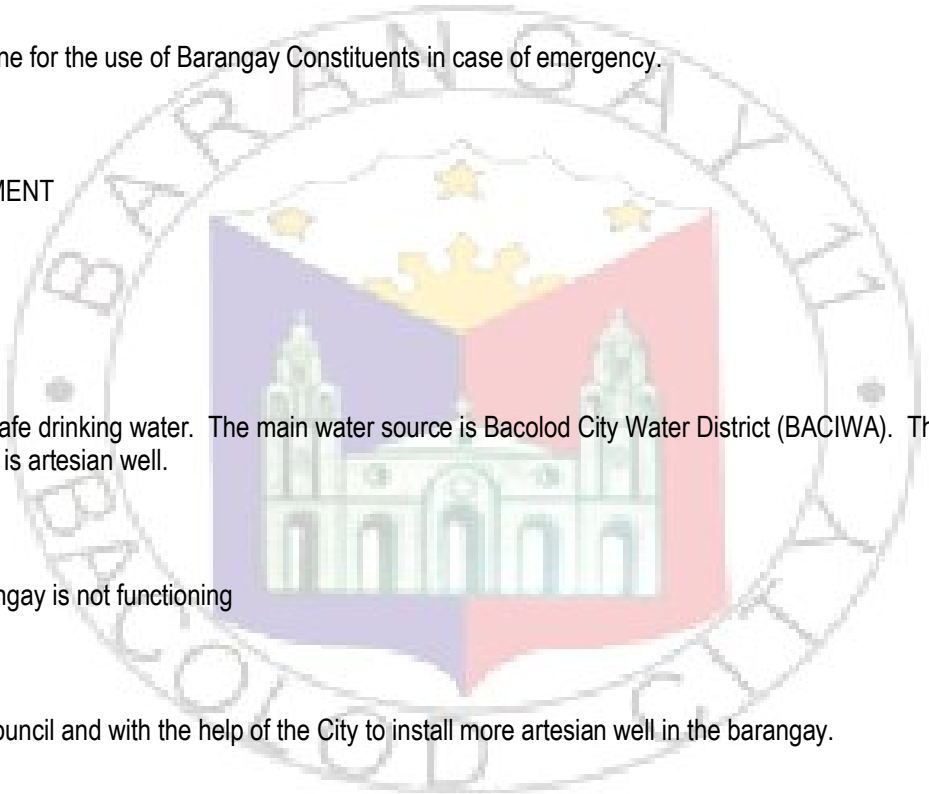
Considering Barangay 11 is the center of the City. Mostly of the household livelihood is boarding house and the boundaries of the area is City Road.
