



**SOCIO ECONOMIC PROFILE
BARANGAY 17
BACOLOD CITY**

I. MISSION OF BARANGAY 17

The continuous delivery of Public Service in a transparent manner through the different programs and projects such as: Maintenance of Peace and Order, Lessen the malnourished children through the continuous implementation of Supplemental Wet Feeding, Micro Nutrients Supplementation through Vitamin A distribution to 0 to 71 months; implementation of infrastructure Projects; Health and Sanitation; Clean and Green Project; Welfare of the Children and Senior Citizens; Education Programs and Livelihood Project.

II. INTRODUCTION

The main objective of the Barangay Development Plan is to give priority to the different Projects of the Barangay, in order that the delivery of basic services shall be well implemented and well fully distributed to all the constituents of the Barangay.

It has been the common practice of every Barangay that the implementation of all the projects are prioritized according to different Economic reasons.

III. AREA DEVELOPMENT FRAMEWORK

Barangay 17 has been the pilot-oriented Barangay in delivering basic services to its constituents. With our recent survey, the commercial establishments has gone up by 25%. This shows that investing at Barangay 17, Bacolod City has been the common byword to every commercial investor to invest in Barangay 17.

With the vision of Bacolod City as globally competitive and a preferred investment center with responsive and environment safety and promotes good governance on Filipino values. Barangay 17 has promised to its constituents that the delivery of basic services shall be fully and visibly implemented according to the provision of the law, with the support of the members of the Barangay 17 Council and most especially of the people of Barangay 17.

With the recent implementation by the City Government of the Solid Waste Management Law, Barangay 17 has gone up to its 100% implementation of the Solid Waste Management Program, with beautification, landscaping, painting of boulders, painting of rubber vases planted at the street gutters.

IV. HISTORICAL BACKGROUND

Like any smaller Barangay, Barangay 17, Bacolod City has no significant History where it got its name. But it was form by virtue of Presidential Decree No. 86 and 86-A. This decree stats that all Barrios and poblacion in the Philippines will be changed into a Barangay.

V. DEMOGRAPHIC PROFILE

Barangay 17 is located at the center of the City of Bacolod, being one of the numbered Barangays, is a walking distance to North Public Market on the South; and on the East, the Bacolod Capitol Lagoon, Development Bank of the Philippines and Veteran's Bank; on the North, by Dunkin Donuts and Virgen sang Barangay Building on the West, Diamond Restaurant and Tita Ping's Restaurant.

POPULATION PROFILE:

A survey was approved by members of the Barangay 17 Council and the Barangay Health Workers were in-charge of this, based on the information instrument prepared by the City Population Office.

EDUCATION:

Barangay 17 has one (1) Day Care Center with 2 sessions, the morning and the afternoon sessions. In the morning, the age is usually from 3 years old while in the afternoon from 4 years old who will be accepted as Preparatory in the next opening school year.

Barangay 17 has one (1) purok to which residents are all squatters yet, they could send their children to school with just peanut and fruit vending as their everyday occupation. There are numerous out-of-school youth in the barangay who failed to continue their studies for the following reasons:

ISSUES AND CONCERNS:

- Parents could not afford to send their children to school.
- Laxity of children to go to school because of broken family.

PROGRAMS AND PROJECTS:

- To put up Scholarship Programs for deserving and intelligent out-of-school youth.
- To conduct Livelihood training/seminar for out-of-school youth.

PROTECTIVE SERVICES:

Under the leadership of Punong Barangay Rogelio Pabiania Jr., Barangay 17 Council created a Committee on Peace and Order and organized Barangay Pulis Laban sa Krimen (BPLK) to maintain Peace and Order in the locality and all the areas of Barangay 17. So far, all the Barangay Tanods are fully equipped with tanod uniforms, hand-held radios and other paraphernalia.

Barangay Tanods have their duties every night under Team A and Team B from 11:00 in the evening until 4:00 in the morning and the Barangay is under BAC-UP 2 Police Precinct.

Barangay 17 is one of the 12 barangays that are under the supervision of BAC-UP 2. The other 11 barangays under the said precinct are: Barangays 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10 and 18.

Not only the barangay tanods are having their nightly roving activities but the Police Officers of the precinct are there to eliminate illegal incidents especially drug-related ones in the barangay.

SOCIAL WELFARE:

Barangay 17 has a Health Center at the ground floor of the Barangay Hall and is a cluster barangay of Barangay 12 wherein all the prenatal check-ups for those who are pregnant are done, distribution of medicines for TB patients and the immunization for 2-15 month old babies.

The Barangay recently conducted seminars/trainings on Reproductive Health for couples that are under their reproductive ages. Likewise, for the pre-schoolers and malnourished children, Barangay 17 conducted quarterly supplemental wet feeding in the four (4) puroks of the barangay.

Barangay 17 asks the help of the following government agencies:

- DSSD
- City Mayor's Office
- Social Welfare Program
- Women's Desk Officer (BCPO)
- Lone District of Bacolod, and
- Different SP Members

HOUSING:

Barangay 17 is composed of 40% commercial, and 60% residential which has a perpetual occupancy for the security of tenure in the Barangay. There are squatter residents at one purok to which the land is owned by a private person. At Purok Pagla-um, mostly all the houses are concrete as they belong to a subdivision; at Purok Pag-asa, since at this purok there are shanties made of woods and nipa, the land is owned by a private person; at Purok Paghidaet 1, most houses are made of concrete materials and at Purok Paghidaet II most houses are made of concrete materials with steel trusses.

ISSUES AND CONCERNS:

There are still families who do not have a perpetual occupancy and considered squatters in the Barangay.

PROGRAMS AND PROJECTS:

The Barangay 17 Council thru Punong Barangay Rogelio Pabiania, Jr. will endorse to the Bacolod Housing Authority that the squatters shall be given priority to apply for a housing assistance.

SPORTS AND RECREATION:

Barangay 17 has three (3) basketball courts, two (2) at Purok Pagla-um and one (1) at Purok Paghidaet 1.

Every 3rd week of April, Barangay 17 is holding Barangay Day, wherein DINAGUSO FESTIVAL is held. There are various activities such as Mini Street Dancing Competition and Dance Showdown. The Sangguniang Kabataan is holding their Annual Sports League participated in by four (4) puroks under different categories such as 21 under, 18 under and the Super Tatay.

COMMERCE SECTOR:

Barangay 17 has 135 commercial establishments at four (4) puroks, eight (8) restaurants and eight (8) banks. There are also sari-sari stores operating, eateries, sing-along/Videoke bars, bakeshops, printing press/Xerox copier operators, fruit vendors and general merchandise.

INFRASTRUCTURE SECTOR:

Since Barangay 17 is at the Center of the City, it is passable by PUJ route, Shopping, Homesite, Villamonte, Eoreco, Sta. Fe and FF Gonzaga.

- Trisikad - there are almost 110 units of trisikads operating in Barangay 17
- Private-owned cars
- Motorcycles
- Jeepneys
- Taxis
- Bicycles / Tricycles
- E-Bikes

There are trisikads and tricycles operating in Barangay 17 without Business Permits nor drivers' without drivers' licence. This is due to lack of personal funds or cannot afford to pay.

As far as infrastructure is concerned, there are two (2) welcome signs located at Purok Pagla-um and Purok Paghidaet 1. And recently, there are two (2) additional Welcome Signs constructed at Puroks Pag-asa and Purok Paghidaet II. The funding was approved under the Annual Investment Plan of the City for Calendar Year, 2014.

Mostly, all roads in Barangay 17 were implemented by the National Government under the budget of the Congressional Representatives. Likewise, all footwalks within the barangay were implemented under Barangay Funds and Annual Investment Plan (AIP) and others from national funds.

Drainage:

Drainage in Barangay 17 was funded under Barangay Funds, Annual Investment Plan and from national funds of the Congressional Representatives. At present, there is already a finished improvement of Drainage at the side of the Iglesia Ni Cristo Church funded under the Annual Investment Plan.

Bridge:

There is one bridge at Purok Pagla-um funded by the late Congressman Romeo Guanzon. This is Mambulok Bridge passing through 1st Street, Guerrero Surveying Office and Corazon Locsin Montelibano Memorial Regional Hospital.

Waiting Shed:

Barangay 17 has one (1) waiting shed located at Purok Pagla-um in front of BDO Bank-Hilado Branch.

Streetlights:

Barangay 17 has a total of 56 streetlight posts located at Puroks Pagla-um, Pag-asa, Paghidaet 1 and Paghidaet II.

WATER SUPPLY / FACILITY:

Barangay 17 main source of potable water is BACIWA. There are three (3) deep wells constructed in the barangay and there are residents using these deep wells.

POWER SUPPLY

Barangay 17 residents and the street lights are being served by Central Negros Electrical Cooperative, Inc. (CENECO).

COMMUNICATIONS:

Barangay 17 is served by landline telephones, PLDT, GLOBELINES, SMART, GLOBE and SUN cellular phones.

The barangay hall is served by PLDT communications and internet facility. This can be used by the public, if there are emergency cases.

D. ENVIRONMENTAL SECTOR

- **LAND RESOURCE MANAGEMENT**
 - 1) 40% Commercial land use
 - 2) 60% Residential land use
- **AIR QUALITY MANAGEMENT**

Barangay 17 in cooperation with its residents are concerned about the environment projects and in nurturing safe air in the environment for the safety and health of the people.
- **WATER RESOURCE MANAGEMENT**

Barangay 17 has a potable water system served by BACIWA for everyday use and there are also purified water stations serving the residents for purified drinking water. The other source of water for households needs are the three (3) deep well stations at the three (3) puroks.

- **SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT / CLEAN AND GREEN PROJECT**

Considering that the barangay is at the heart of the city and being one of the urban barangays, the main source of livelihood and income earner are the 40% commercial establishments, there are also boarding houses operating in the barangay, and these are at:

1. Purok Paghidaet I = 8
2. Purok Paghidaet II = 7
3. Purok Pagla-um = 19
4. Purok Pag-asa = 2

There are a total of 40 boarding houses serving in Barangay 17.

Residents in the barangay put their wastes in plastic bags and sacks and is placed in the designated areas where the garbage collectors who leave these garbage hanging. We have the newly-installed Materials Recovery Facility (MRF) at the side of the Iglesia Ni Cristo Church. There are painted bamboo fences surrounding the vegetable gardens.

In the recently concluded contest on the Cleanest and Greenest Most Highly-Urbanized Barangay in Bacolod City, the Barangay got 3rd Place and it is an honor for Barangay 17.

ISSUES AND CONCERNS:

1. Unidentified residents and neighboring barangays throw their garbage on our landscaped gardens during night time.
2. Many stray dogs are loitering and have their wastes on the streets during night time.

PROGRAMS AND PROJECTS

- Proper schedule of garbage dump trucks.
- Put signages in areas in dumping garbage.
- Educating owners of the dogs not to let their dogs stray around and have their wastes on the streets as it catches a sore eye on street passers not only this, it leaves a foul odor which is hazardous to health.
