VISION:

As part of the Council, our vision is to deliver the programs and projects to our constituents with transparency, sustainability and sufficient adhering to the needs of the community.

MISSION:

To provide the optimum welfare of Barangay 2 constituents in all aspects of their needs with regard to safety and security through Peace and Order programs, Barangay Infrastructure projects, Health needs through Health programs, Women, Family and Social Services programs, Educational programs and Income generating programs (LIVELIHOOD).

HISTORICAL BACKGROUND

Barangay 2 was created on 1985 under City Ordinance No. 08, approving and adopting the recommended delineation of boundaries of Sixty One Urban and Rural Barangay.

Barangay 2 is one of the Forty One (41) Urban Barangay situated on the Northern portion of the City of Bacolod. It is a shoreline Barangay and commonly known as "Shoreline Bounty".

It was noted that the first Kapitan del Barrio was the late Crispi Meorada Sr., then Jose "Boy" Cuadra as acting Barangay Captain for a short period, followed by Jose "Boy" Galvez who served as the longest tenure among the Barangay Captain mentioned. In 2004 Steve Mendoza was elected. In year 2007 and 2013 Barangay Captain Richard O. Barber was elected by the resident. Victor "Thords" Aliguin assumed office after Barangay Captain Richard Barber sudden death in January 2015. Punong Barangay Emelda J. Banguanga created history as the first lady elected and serve as the Barangay Captain in 2010, she was again elected in May 2018 election.

LAND AREA AND OTHER DATA:

Barangay 2, is one of the Urban Barangay which is geographically located in the Northern Portion of the City. It has a Total Land Area of 9, 1347 hectares or 91, 347 square meters. It is 100% plain and the whole area of Barangay 2, mostly residential and it has a few commercial establishments.

It is comprises of Five (5) Puroks namely: Purok Sigay, Purok Kagaykay, Purok Tahong, Purok Balinday and Purok Lampirong, and the major industry is Fishing, Crab gathering and Fish and Crab Vending.

SECTORAL PROFILE

A. SOCIAL SECTOR HEALTH:

The health of residents of Barangay No. 2, is one of the main focus of the present administration. Most of the indigent resident suffer from cases like A.G.E. (Diarrhea), Intestinal Parasitism, A.R.I., and T.B. (all forms) and malnutrition due to lack of awareness on proper sanitation and medicines.

EDUCATION:

BARANGAY No. 2, having one (1) Barangay Day Care Center, located at Purok Kagaykay, which caters Pre-Schoolers all over Barangay 2 as well as the neighboring barangays and with the mutual cooperation of Augustinian Sisters and Barangay 2, utilized it funds to feed malnourished Pre-Schooler Children. About 20% enrolled at Private Schools, Children in the primary/elementary level are enrolled at Andres Bonifacio Elementary School I, II and III. While the secondary level were mostly enrolled at Domingo Lacson National High School and Negros Occidental High School. In addition, our Barangay adopted Twenty Six (26) Barangay Scholar Students intended for Barangay Indigent Families and these scholars were enrolled at Bacolod City College (BCC).

PROTECTIVE SERVICE:

In BARANGAY No. 2, there is intensification and massive campaign on Drug Prevention and Control by the following manpower existing in the Barangay. Some of them are the presence of Police Station 2, PDEA Operative, Functional Barangay Council for the Protection of Children and Barangay Tanod with the following services rendered such as: securing the peace and order program at Five (5) Puroks through night roving of assigned tanods every night. Families along the shoreline area severely affected by the natural disaster.

SOCIAL WELFARE:

BARANGAY 2, has one Social Worker on duty every Tuesday and Thursday. One (1) Day Care Center with one (1) Day Care Worker. That based on the survey, there are minimal street children, such as bystander who came from the other neighboring Barangay likewise minimal rugby sniffing children. One (1) active Senior Citizen Organization. Some identified people's organization summarized as follows: [1] INA-KALIPE (women Organization); [2] Trisikad Driver's Organization; [3] Fisher Folks Association; [4] Day Care-Parent Committee Group [5]Pag-asa Youth Association of the Philippines (PYA).

HOUSING:

Most of the residents are squatters but they owned their houses. Some are paying for their lot monthly, but some are house renter. Obviously, the houses are overcrowded. Bacolod Housing Authority conducted information education in cases of demolition. Most of the houses are safe to live though some are made of dilapidated materials. Houses located at the foreshore area are considered typhoon prone.

SPORTS AND RECREATION:

BARANGAY 2, through the existing sports program from way back which was continuously supported by the Barangay Council initiated every year the InterPurok Basketball and Volleyball League as well as the Socio-Cultural Activities. The most identified and recognized sport facility is located at Purok Kagaykay and it is approximately 900 square meter in area occupied which is totally privately owned.

B. ECONOMIC SECTOR COMMERCE:

Some of the commercial establishments identified in Barangay 2 are as follows:

Latest survey shows that there are Thirty (30) existing Sari-sari Stores in the area.

INDUSTRY:

In terms of industry, the Barangay 2 identified one crab meat export processing. It has created over a hundred employment and some of them are Out of School Youth. The major industry here in Barangay 2, is Fishing, Crab gathering and Fish and Crab Vending.

SOURCES OF INCOME & TYPE OF OCCUPATION:

Majority of these gainful workers belong to stevedores, related freight handlers and other laborers. Then it followed by: Drivers, Mechanics, Carpenters, Dressmakers and similar workers. Minority of these gainful workers were

Seamen. The reason why majority are stevedores is that Barangay 2, is a coastal Barangay, it is near and distance to Banago Wharf and Reclamation Area.

C. ENVIRONMENT SECTOR

BARANGAY 2, residents are trained in doing appropriate Solid Waste Management. However, 2 Puroks are greatly affected during man made calamities such as floods. Purok Sigay is considered flood prone area due to the situation that when the high tide and low tide co-inside (Catch Basin) with heavy rains including Purok Kagaykay. The quality of water is potable, safe for drinking. There is air pollution due to overcrowding.
