HISTORICAL BACKGROUND

Barangay 23 is one of the neighbourhood community within Bacolod City, through Presidential Decree No.557 structured September 21, 1974, became the basic political unit in the Philippine Local Government System. It was only on December 17, 1983, City Ordinance No. 08 approving and adopting the delineation of boundaries of sixty one (61) Barangays in the City of Bacolod. All powers, function, duties and responsibilities of Barrios, Assembly, Councils and Officials enumerated in the revised Barrio Charter (RA 3590) was assimilated by the Barangay in shaping up public policy Barangays play their big participation as well.

Land Area and Other Data

Barangay 23 is one (1) community which is geographically located within the heart of Bacolod City. It has a plain land area of 6.5134 hectares square meters, comprises four (4) blocks four (4) component purok namely:

1. Purok Gahili-ugyon
2. Purok Masinulondon
3. Purok Nagabinuligay
4. Purok Maninangpanon

It is bounded by the following Barangay:

NE – along the centreline of Galo Street (from the intersection of Hilado Street and Galo Street) intersecting Lopez Jaena Street, which is Barangay 20.

SE – along the centreline of Galo Street (from the intersection of Lopez Jaena Street) intersecting Rizal Street which is Barangay 27.

SW – along the centreline of Rizal Street (from the intersection of Lopez Jaena and Rizal Street) intersecting Hilado Street which is Barangay 26.

NW – along the centreline of Hilado Street (from the intersection of Rizal Street and Hilado Street) intersecting Galo Street which is Barangay 22.

Health

Our barangay Health Center can be found at the City Health Compound. It is benefited our Barangay in all their needs especially pertaining records, dental and consultation. Most common cases in our indigents residence especially children suffering from A.G.E. (Diarrhea) intestinal parasitism, A.R.I.T.B. and malnutrition due to lack of medicine and proper sanitation.

Education

Barangay 23 has a Day Care Center for students 3-4 years old as for preparatory training to elementary. Upon graduation from day care center some students enrolled at A. Mabini Elementary School, G. Lopez Jaena Elementary School while their high school they enrol at Bacolod City National High School, Negros Occidental High School and for their college they enrol at the nearby colleges and universities.

3. Over age to continue for elementary grade or high school **Issue/s:**

1. Lack of new book for advance learning
2. Lack of playground facilities for pre-schoolers
3. Small toilet space
