HISTORY OF THE BARANGAY

A Barangay is a Government Unit; the nation locally based political structure under Presidential Decree No. 557 dated September 21, 1974 which created the Barangay to provided popular participation in shaping up public policy, All powers, function, duties and responsibilities of basic assembly , Council and Officials enumerated in the revised barrio chapter (RA 3590) is assimilated by the Barangay.

When our Late President Ferdinand E. Marcos reactivated the Barangay Governance in the Philippines. The first Barangay Captain – Appointed was the Late Felipa Cababao followed by Barangay Captain – elect Rodolfo J. Besana, Anecito Cabaobao, Jessie Arroyo and newly elected Leif Gregory D. Ledesma.

Barangay 24 was composed of Two (2) puroks, namely Masinadyahon, Standard, Salsalon and Kalubihan but two (2) puroks were later abolished, namely Salsalon and Kalubihan because the areas were converted into commercials buildings.

Barangay 24 is an urban barangay with total land area of 53,222 sq. m. more or less, bounded along and within Mabini St., Lacson St., Rizal St., Gonzaga St., and Cuadra St., Presently the Barangay has 31 household families, 341 registered voters as of 2019 Barangay Election and 168 commercial establishments, business or officers, it is near or within the commercial district of Bacolod City. Approxiatly 100 – 200 meters from the City Public Plaza and 200-300 meters from the City Hall.

EDUCATION

HOUSING

Barangay 24, has 31 number of household/families and 168 commercial establishments, businesses or offices mostly owned by private individuals or corporation, Barangay residents, laborers/personnel and their families, renters and daily wage earners like carpenter, electricians, owner of small stores, café/cigarettes stand and etc.

SOCIAL WELFARE

Barangay 24 has also a Barangay Nutrition Program and Health Center at Apolinario Mabini Elementary School. These are intend for the development of the pre-school children below 6 years old. The Center also provide pre-marital counseling, family planning, awareness of responsible parenthood, immunization for prevention of diseases on scheduled basis, first aid, medical consultation and nutrition education information.

SPORTS AND RECREATION

Barangay 24 youth or students comprise a minority of the total population of the Barangay still the Barangay implement sports program thru the effort of the Sk Officials and as the popular saying goes, "A healthy mind and body is wealth."

PEACE & ORDER

Crime committed within the Barangay jurisdiction Are theft, robbery, snatcher, pick pocketing, vandalism, crimes against property and petty crimes. Crime rate in the Barangay is lower compared to the city average. Other cases are martial conflict and collection /sum of money.

Commercial building owners and tenants hire security guards to protect their property during night time. One of the project of the Barangay is to help in crime prevention. Through its Barangay Tanods and the same time the vigilance of the residents, we will be able to keep a watchful eye on our Barangay. BAC-UP 1 Police Station

Water Supply

Narration or brief description

Barangay 24 is efficiently served by the Bacolod Water District (BACIWA) and two(1) artesian well/deep wells one (1) outside the Barangay Hall. There are no water peddler, water pollution and rivers within the Barangay except for a small creek in between Rizal and Gonzaga Street which was alter converted into a drainage system of the Barangay.

A Random survey with BACIWA consumer in the Barangay said that they are all satisfied with their services.

POWER SUPPLY

Narration or brief description

Barangay 24 is efficiently served by the CENTRAL NEGROS ELECTRIC COOPERATION (CENECO). As per random survey with several consumers/residents within the Barangay , they are satisfied with the services it provides. However, there are several complaints and comment that the service provide is charging high electric charges due to the Power Purchase Adjustment & Other charges. In case of occasional brownout, most resident use candles, while some commercial establishment have stand by generators. All residents and those in the food business uses liquefied petroleum gas and charcoal for cooking.

ENVIRONMENTAL SECTOR

Narration or brief description

Barangay 24 surrounding are generally fair/ minimal in terms of pollution , flooding since it has no flood prone are except for stagnant water during rainy season, clogged drainage , which were covered during the widening and concreting of city street along Gonzaga, Rizal and Cuadra streets.

Stagnant water causes health problem like dengue fever. These clogged up drainage and several covered manholes can later cause flooding, especially in low lying areas.

The air quality within the Barangay is quite minimal but pollutants are mostly caused or emitted by motor vehicle.

SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT
