HISTORICAL BACKGROUND

In the early years of its existence, Barangay 40 used to be a cogonal area, while vast track of land was planted to sugarcane. A trailroad track was constructed in the center of Barangay leading to a sugar mill at a distance where Barangay 41 now situates, Central Bacolod-Murcia.

Through the years, sugar cane workers started to build houses in the heart of the Barangay were landed family dwelt, prominent of whom the Lizares family, who until now is considered patrons of Barangay 40.

In 1973, Presidential Declaration No. 86 and 86-A created Barangay 1 to 41 as a Poblacion Barangays or Urban Barangays.

DEMOGRAPHIC CHARACTERISTICS

Barangay 40 is geographically located at the south east portion of the city. It is bounded on the north by Barangays 30, 31 and 33 with centreline at Hernaez St., Barangay 39 at the southwest with centreline at Lacson Extension and Barangay Taculing on the east bounded by Magsungay River. (Lupit Bridge) Magsungay River to Lacson and Libertad St., to Magsungay Bridge to Lupit Bridge going to Murcia.
