RESOLUTION REQUESTING ALL THE CITY GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES TO ACTIVELY PARTICIPATE IN THE CELEBRATION OF THE 122ND PHILIPPINE CIVIL SERVICE THIS MONTH OF SEPTEMBER 2022.

Upon motion of Councilor Simplicia Z. Distrito, jointly seconded by Floor Leader Al Victor A. Espino, Councilors Celia Matea R. Flor, Claudio Jesus Raymundo A. Puentevella and Jude Thaddeus A. Sayson, the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Bacolod

RESOLVED, to pass the following resolution:

WHEREAS, on September 19, 1900, the Philippine Civil Service was established by virtue of Public Law No. 5 or known as, "An Act for the Establishment and Maintenance of an Efficient and Honest Civil Service in the Philippine Islands";

WHEREAS, Presidential Proclamation No. 1050, Series of 1970 was passed, declaring the month of September as the Civil Service Month and the celebration is spearheaded by the Civil Service Commission;

WHEREAS, this year is the 122nd celebration of the Philippine Civil Service with the theme: "Transforming Public Service in the Next Decade: Honing Agile and Future-Ready Servant-Heroes". The thematic focus for this year is on resilience, that is seen during the pandemic crisis and in calamities where civil service is shown ready to accept challenges and be able to give continued assistance to the public;



WHEREAS, the City Government of Bacolod, through the efforts and initiative of the Human Resource Management Service (HRMS) has organized activities to commemorate the celebration in coordination with various City Departments;

WHEREAS, as per the HRMS, the celebration for this year reflects on the path the civil service has to take to build on the gains of last year's modernization efforts in the wake of the COVID-19 pandemic and the role of HR in building a competent and credible workforce in the new normal;
