**RESOLUTION RESPECTFULLY REQUESTING THE HONORABLE CITY MAYOR ALFREDO ABELARDO B. BENITEZ TO STUDY THE FEASIBILITY OF INSTALLING SOLAR POWERED STREET LIGHTS AND SOLAR CELLS/PANELS IN THE BACOLOD CITY GOVERNMENT CENTER TO DEFRAY THE CITY'S EXPENSES ON ELECTRICITY.**

Upon motion of Councilor Claudio Jesus Raymundo A. Puentevella, jointly seconded by Councilors Celia Matea R. Flor and Jason Isidro S. Villarosa the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Bacolod

**RESOLVED**, to pass the following resolution:

**WHEREAS**, Section 16 of Article II of the 1987 Philippine Constitution provides that the State shall protect and advance the right of the people to a balanced and healthful ecology in accord with the rhythm and harmony of nature.

**WHEREAS**, Section 2, paragraph C of Republic Act No. 9513 or otherwise known as the Renewable Energy Act of 2008 encourages the development and utilization of renewable energy resources as tools to effectively prevent or reduce harmful emissions and thereby balance the goals of economic growth and development with the protection of health and the environment;

**WHEREAS**, the use and promotion of renewable energy sources as an alternative to fossil fuels lessens the carbon footprint and emissions that may affect the environment.

**WHEREAS**, solar power is a form of renewable energy source that uses sunlight, which is composed of photon energy particles being collected by Photovoltaic Panel or also known as solar panels and converted into electricity that provides power for electrical loads.

**WHEREAS**, the installation and use of solar power in the Bacolod City Government Center will lessen the City's expenses on electrical utilities and helps lessen the carbon footprint that is harmful to the environment.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED**, to respectfully request the Honorable City Mayor Alfredo Abelardo B. Benitez to study the feasibility of installing solar powered street lights and solar cells/panels in the Bacolod City Government Center to defray the city's expenses on electricity.




