RESOLUTION URGING THE CITY HEALTH OFFICE THROUGH MAYOR ALFREDO ABELARDO B. BENITEZ TO STRICTLY IMPLEMENT CITY ORDINANCE NO. 893 OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE BACOLOD HEALTHY LIFESTYLE CAMPAIGN ORDINANCE.

Upon motion of Councilor Em L. Ang, jointly seconded by Councilors Claudio Jesus Raymundo A. Puentevella, Israel P. Salanga, Jason Isidro S. Villarosa and Lady Gles Gonzales-Pallen, the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Bacolod

RESOLVED, to pass the following resolution:

WHEREAS, Section 2, Article II of the 1987 Philippine Constitution provides that, "The State shall protect and promote the right to health of the people and instill health consciousness among them";

WHEREAS, City Ordinance No. 893 has been passed last May 15, 2019 with the main purpose of minimizing the prevalence of obesity and overweight among Bacolod City residents through healthy lifestyle campaigns such as a healthy diet, continuous physical activities and wellness programs;



WHEREAS, for the reason of city-wide lockdowns which limits the mobility of Bacolod City residents for almost two years, the implementation of the said ordinance had a break and the incidence of obesity and other non-communicable diseases such as diabetes and hypertension increased;

WHEREAS, according to the Expanded National Nutrition Survey 2021, Bacolod City has an obesity prevalence of Thirteen (13) percent and an overweight prevalence of Twenty-one (21) percent among Bacolod City residents ages 0 to 40 years old as compared to the 2019 survey which only reported Ten (10) percent obesity and Twelve (12) percent overweight prevalence;

WHEREAS, as per the data from the City Health Office as of the first half or from January to June of 2022, Bacolod City already has a non-communicable disease (NCD) total incidence of Three Thousand Five Hundred Seventy-One (3,571) which is Fifteen percent (15%) higher compared to the same period last year;

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the City Government of Bacolod to strictly implement the above-mentioned Ordinance to help reduce the incidence of obesity and other non-communicable diseases among its constituents by instilling a healthy lifestyle and strengthening wellness programs;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to urge the City Health Office through Mayor Alfredo Abelardo B. Benitez to strictly implement City Ordinance No. 893 otherwise known as The Bacolod Healthy Lifestyle Campaign Ordinance.


