RESOLUTION RESPECTFULLY REQUESTING MR. RAMIL PALALON HEAD, DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SERVICES (DPS), THROUGH HONORABLE CITY MAYOR ALFREDO ABELARDO B. BENITEZ, TO PLACE ADEQUATE GARBAGE BINS AND PORTALETTS IN THE DIFFERENT VENUES OF EVENTS AND ACTIVITIES DURING THE DURATION OF THE MASSKARA FESTIVAL.


Upon motion of Councilor Claudio Jesus Raymundo A. Puentevella, jointly seconded by Councilors Celia Matea R. Flor and Simplicia Z. Distrito, the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Bacolod

RESOLVED, to pass the following resolution:

WHEREAS, Section 15 of Article II of the 1987 Philippine Constitution provides that the State shall protect and promote the right to health of the people and instill health consciousness among them.

WHEREAS, Section 16 of Article II of the 1987 Philippine Constitution provides that the State shall protect and advance the right of the people to a balanced and healthful ecology in accord with the rhythm and harmony of nature.

WHEREAS, the Masskara Festival attracts thousands of people coming to Bacolod City to celebrate festivities;



WHEREAS, it is expected that during the Masskara Celebration people will indiscriminately throw their garbage during street parties and other grand celebrations;

WHEREAS, there is a need to place garbage bins in significant places during the abovementioned activities in order to control or minimize littering and instill cleanliness and discipline among our citizenry;

WHEREAS, to accommodate the needs of the people during the festivities and celebration, there is a need to place portalets in some significant portions of the celebrations;

WHEREAS, the installation of portalets and garbage bins will prevent the proliferation of disease vectors, pest and spread of other infectious diseases jeopardizing the health of the general public.

WHEREAS, this resolution urges the whole citizenry to observe cleanliness during the celebration of the Masskara Festival;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to respectfully request Mr. Ramil Palalon Head, Department of Public Services (DPS), through Honorable City Mayor Alfredo Abelardo B. Benitez, to place adequate garbage bins and portalets in the different venues of events and activities during the duration of the Masskara Festival


Councilor Jason Isidro S. Villarosa was not around when this resolution was passed.
