CITY ORDINANCE NO. 650

June 26, 2013

**AN ORDINANCE CODIFYING ALL REGULATIONS OF THE OPERATION OF
MOTORIZED TRICYCLE FOR HIRE, GRANTING FRANCHISE FOR OPERATION THEREOF
WITHIN THE TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION OF THE CITY OF BACOLOD, PROVIDING
PENALTIES IN VIOLATION THEREOF.**

WHEREAS, Section 7 of City Ordinance No. 185 provides for the areas where motorized tricycles may be allowed to operate under a specific association, their respective terminals and the number of units allowed to ply within a specified route;

WHEREAS, the city's rapid growth in the last five (5) years necessitates amendments to the existing ordinance governing the operation of motorized tricycles, the number of units, terminals identified and earlier-defined routes;

WHEREAS, several subdivisions and communities had mushroomed for the last SIX (6) YEARS in the city which prompted the subdivision homeowners to request for public transportation to be made available to their residents and that the most convenient and fastest means that they will be immediately provided with public transportation is through motorized tricycle;

WHEREAS, in some other areas where existing routes had already been defined by an existing ordinance, the sudden increase in population likewise constrained motorized tricycle associations to request for additional units to be allowed to ply in routes specified under said ordinance and to request for additional areas to be served in order to adopt with the fast changing times;

WHEREAS, Republic Act 7160 provides that the authority to grant franchise for motorized tricycles and to regulate the operation thereof, is devolved to the local government units, the Sangguniang Panlungsod in particular, in relation to their respective territorial jurisdiction;

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Bacolod in a session assembled that:

Section 1- Section 7 of City Ordinance No. 185 series of 1997 as amended by City Ordinance No. 288, series of 2001 and City Ordinance No. 436, series of 2007; with both amendments hereby repealed, will now read as follows:

The recognition of a particular association in this Section shall not be construed as a grant of a franchise, exclusive use of said route and terminal or the prohibition of the formation of any Association. As long as a particular unit is issued a franchise to operate a motorized tricycle for hire by the city, the same shall be allowed to operate as such and the unhampered use of the terminal as so provided for under this Ordinance;

Section 2 – The Role of Officials of the Associations Recognized Under this Ordinance.

The Association Officials shall be responsible in the recommendation of members who will be issued a Franchise to Operate, composing the number of units allowed in that specified route through a Board Resolution duly approved in a meeting called for that purpose. The recommendation is necessary before a Franchise to Operate is issued to the applicant by the City.

However, the SP Chairman of the Committee on Transportation and Traffic Management may overrule said recommendation through a RESOLUTION duly passed and approved, if it is shown that said Association Officials abuse their authority and discretion in the grant of recommendation or are making unnecessary demand for huge membership fees as a precondition thereof, or he may altogether recommend for the stripping off of that authority to recommend from the Association Officials and may takeover said function or assign it to the barangay official, purok president or any person who commands respect in the community, again through a resolution duly passed and approved by the City Council.

Section 3 - CREATION OF FARE REGULATORY BOARD AND ITS FUNCTIONS.

There shall be created a Fare Regulatory Board to be composed of the following members, to wit:

CHAIRMAN:	SP Chairman of the Committee on Transportation
Members:	Head, Bacolod Traffic Authority
	Representative from the City Administrator
	Representative from the City Legal Officer
	Representative from CAFTODA



The function of the Fare Regulatory Board is to determine the fare matrix for a particular route per passenger or per kilometers radius per passenger and to receive petition for fare rate increase from the applicants-associations, or for rate fare rollback petition from the passengers, as the case may be.

No fare rate increase or fare rate rollback will take effect until approved by the Board and concurred by the City Council.

Section 4.- GROUNDS FOR REVOCATION OR CANCELLATION OF FRANCHISE.

The Franchise to Operate a Motorized Tricycle for Hire may be revoked, cancelled or voided based on the following grounds, to wit:

a.- Three (3) traffic violations committed in a year by the same driver, operating the same unit, provided that the operator is duly informed of said fact prior to the third violation with a warning that another infraction by the same driver in a year shall result to the revocation or cancellation of his franchise;

b.-Non-renewal of Franchise for three (3) consecutive years;

c.- Utilizing subject tricycle unit in the commission of a crime, provided that the operator is aware of said fact or is the driver of the same;

The Bacolod Traffic Authority shall recommend to the City Council for the revocation or cancellation of Franchise on any of the grounds cited above. If there are basis for said revocation, the City Council shall direct the City Licensing and Permits Division to appropriately cancel or revoke said franchise through a resolution.

Section 5 - Repealing Clause. City Ordinance No. 288, Series of 2001 and City Ordinance No. 436, Series of 2001 are accordingly superseded by this Ordinance.

Section 6 - Separability Clause. Any provision of this Ordinance which may be declared ineffective will not affect the other provisions not so declared by a court of competent jurisdiction.

Section 7 - Effectivity Clause. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval in accordance with law.




