**CITY ORDINANCE NO. 517
February 10, 2010**

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE NAMES OF THE STREETS IN BARANGAY GRANADA, CITY OF BACOLOD AS FOLLOWS: 1. MAKILAN STREET TO PEDRO B. AGUILAR STREET, 2. MEDEL STREET TO F. HECHANOVA STREET, 3. RIVERA STREET TO FELIPE RAMIREZ STREET, DETERMINING THE ENTIRETY OF ITS DISTANCE/LOCATION AND PROVIDING THE FUNDS FOR ITS IMPLEMENTATION.

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Bacolod City is empowered under Chapter 2 of Section 13 Par B of R.A. 7160 series of 1991 which authorizes the Sanggunians of highly urbanized and component cities for the purpose of renaming in sub-section 2 of city roads, avenues, boulevards, thoroughfares and bridges under and with consultation to the former National Historical Commission, now the National Historical Institute (NHI);

WHEREAS, Barangay Granada Council Resolution No. 105, series of 2009 states that “resolution endorsing to the Office of the Sangguniang Panlungsod Bacolod City the approved partial renaming of the following three (3) identified streets in Barangay Granada this city”, and as mentioned in the above title of the propose ordinance;

WHEREAS, it is clearly stated in the same Barangay Resolution No. 105, series of 2009, particularly in the Resolved Further which states “the Barangay Council manifestly requesting the Sangguniang Panlungsod, this city thru Hon. Alex A. Paglumotan for drafting the City Ordinance in relation of the renaming of streets in the barangay”;

WHEREAS, the names mentioned in the title have had contributed to the evolution of development and progress in the entire community of Barangay Granada as follows, PEDRO B. AGUILAR SR. “was the former Tenyente del Barrio of Barangay Granada this city, wherein during his time the barrio hall and Emiliano Lizares High School were constructed and that, he deserves to be acknowledged”, the “LATE F. HECHANOVA was the donor of the land as to where the Granada Public Market was erected and that, he deserves to be acknowledged” and the LATE FELIPE RAMIREZ, was the donor of a parcel of land as to where the Barangay Public Plaza is situated as well as the Barangay Hall, Health Center, Playground, Balay Palangabuhian and the Police Station 5 and that, he deserves to be acknowledged”;

WHEREAS, there were two separate SP joint committee/public hearings conducted for the purpose, dated November 12 and December 8, 2009 respectively, and the same have resulted to “positive and unanimous response from both the Barangay Council of Granada and the people/families of Ramirez’s, Aguilar’s and the Hechanovas;

WHEREAS, the incumbent City Mayor Evelio R. Leonardia is overwhelmingly supporting this gesture of the City Council to recognize and give honor to those individuals who have contributed their timeless efforts, resources and to the development of progress and both socio-economic and political landscape of our basic communities, thus, this recognition is due to the above mentioned personalities of Barangay Granada.

NOW THEREFORE be it ordained by the Honorable Members of the Sangguniang Panlungsod in session:

Section 1 – Title: This ordinance shall be known as:

- a) PEDRO B. AGUILAR STREET
- b) F. HECHANOVA STREET
- c) FELIPE RAMIREZ STREET

Section 2. Coverage: For the sole purpose of this ordinance, it shall be the duty of the City Planning and Development Office (CPDO), the City Engineer's Office (CEO) and other line agencies of this LGU to determine, assess and in any applicable technical manner the coverage of the abovementioned road.

Section 3. Funds and Implementation: The amount of not more than ONE HUNDRED THOUSAND PESOS (Php 100,000.00) shall be appropriated for the purpose of establishing and appropriate signage/s to be undertaken by the City Engineer's Office (CEO) and based on the actual survey to be conducted by the Bacolod City Planning and Development Office (CPDO) prior to the approval of this proposed ordinance.

Section 4. Effectivity: This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval in accordance with law.
