**CITY ORDINANCE NO. 08-15-744
June 17, 2015**

**AN ORDINANCE SETTING THE THIRD WEEK OF THE MONTH OF APRIL EVERY
YEAR AS THE BACOLOD CITY FOOTBALL FESTIVAL WEEK.**

WHEREAS, the 1987 Philippine Constitution provides that the State shall promote physical education and encourage sports programs, league competitions, and amateur sports including training for international competitions, to foster self-discipline, teamwork, and excellence for the development of a healthy and alert citizenry;

WHEREAS, football is the most popular sport in the world and it appears to be steadily rising as one of the major sports in the Philippines particularly in the City of Bacolod;

WHEREAS, the City of Bacolod has been known to produce football champions and continuously taken its role in propelling and strengthening football in the country;

WHEREAS, Bacolodnons should not only be morally upright, mentally educated, and socially relevant but must also be physically sound and healthy.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Bacolod City in session assembled that:

SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE. – The short title of this Ordinance shall be known as the “Bacolod City Football Festival Week”.

SECTION 2 . FOOTBALL FESTIVAL WEEK. – The City of Bacolod shall observe the third (3rd) week of April every year as the Football Festival Week and shall accordingly hold a week-long activity in the City.

SECTION 3. COMMITTEE. – There shall be a Committee who will plan out and oversee the implementation of the Ordinance. The Committee shall be composed of but not limited to the following:

- a. City Mayor's Office
- b. SP Chairperson, Committee on Sports
- c. Bacolod City Sports Office
- d. Commission on Higher Education
- e. Department of Education, Division of Bacolod
- f. Federation of the Bacolod City Parents-Teachers Community Association
- g. Negros Occidental Private Schools Sports, Cultural and Educational Association (NOPSSCEA)
- h. Negros Occidental Football Association

SECTION 4. FUNDING. – The City of Bacolod shall appropriate an annual funding of One Hundred Thousand Pesos (Php 100,000.00) for the realization and meaningful implementation of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE.– If, for any reason or reasons, any section or provision of this ordinance shall be held to be unconstitutional or invalid, other sections or provisions hereof which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in force and effect.

SECTION 6. REPEALING CLAUSE. – All ordinances, rules and regulations or any part thereof, which are inconsistent or in conflict with any of the provision of this ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 7. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE. - This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval.






