CITY ORDINANCE NO. 847
April 4, 2018

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 1, 2 (A) AND (B), 2.A, 3 AND 5 OF CITY ORDINANCE NO. 482, SERIES OF 2009, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A YEARLY FESTIVITIES TO BE KNOWN AS THE MANOKAN COUNTRY INASAL FESTIVAL IN THE CITY OF BACOLOD INCORPORATING A SPECIAL COMMITTEE TO BE CREATED AND PROVIDING FUNDS FOR ITS IMPLEMENTATION".

WHEREAS, City Ordinance No. 482, Series of 2009 entitled "An Ordinance Establishing A Yearly Festivities To Be Known As The Manokan Country Inasal Festival In The City Of Bacolod Incorporating A Special Committee To Be Created And Providing Funds For Its Implementation" was passed on February 18, 2009 for the purpose of staging a yearly Inasal Festival in the City of Bacolod and to promote the chicken inasal industry of the City;

WHEREAS, the festival aims to establish the ownership of the intangible cultural heritage of the chicken inasal as a Bacolod original;

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained as it is hereby ordained by the Sangguniang Panlungsod in session assembled, that:

SECTION 1. Section 1 of the City ordinance No. 482, Series of 2009, which reads:

Section 1 - Title: This ordinance shall be known as the "Manokan Country Inasal Festival" in the City of Bacolod.

Shall be amended to read as:

This ordinance shall be known as "**Bacolod Chicken Inasal Festival**".

SECTION 2. Section 2(a) and (b) of the City Ordinance No. 482, Series of 2009, which reads:

Section 2 – Definition of Terms: For the purpose of this ordinance, the following terms shall be defined as follows:

- a. **Chicken Inasal – famous and original Bacolod chicken inasal**
- b. **Festival – the yearly event to be established**

Shall be amended to read as:

- a. Chicken Inasal – refers to skewered chargrilled or roasted chicken, marinated in a mixture of lime, pepper, vinegar and annatto then grilled over hot coals while basted with the marinade, an original recipe that originated from Bacolod, and has since become an icon of Bacolod City.

- b. Bacolod Chicken Inasal Festival – refers to the yearly event that is aimed at showcasing the chicken inasal of the City of Bacolod.

SECTION 3. Section 2.a. of the City ordinance No. 482, Series of 2009, which reads:

“Section 2.a. Coverage: The yearly Inasal Festival to be managed by the special committee as mentioned in Section 3 shall have the exclusive coverage from the corner of Rizal-Ferrero streets encompassing the whole Manokan Country area up to the corner of Burgos-Ferrero streets only. Any proposed additional area to be made by the special committee as additional venue for the festivity shall be subject to the approval of the Sangguniang Panlungsod at last 15 days prior to the staging of the Inasal Festival”.

Shall be amended to read as:

“COVERAGE. The yearly Bacolod Chicken Inasal Festival shall be managed by the special committee. The venue for the festivity shall be identified by the special committee”.

SECTION 4. Section 3 of the City Ordinance No. 482, Series of 2009, which reads:

“Section 3 – Special Committee and its composition: There shall be a special committee to be created by the City Mayor through an executive order and has the following composition:

***City Mayor – Honorary Chairman
City Councilors (as Chairmen/Chairpersons of the SP Committee on Tourism and Public Markets) to serve as co-chairmen***


Members of the Special Committee:

***Head of the City Tourism Department
City Administrator or designated representative
City Engineer’s Office – representative
CPDO head or representative
BCPO chief or designated representative
2 or 3 members coming from the private sector
1 from the business sector
President of the Manokan Country occupants/tenants***

Shall be amended to read as:

SPECIAL COMMITTEE AND ITS COMPOSITION. A special committee is hereby created and shall be composed of the following:

Chairman : City Mayor
Co-Chairmen : Chairman, SP Committee on Tourism, and Local, National and International Cooperation
Chairman, SP Committee on Markets and Slaughterhouse



Members: City Administrator
City Tourism Officer
City Engineer
City Planning and Development Officer
Head of City Mayor's Office-Sectoral Concerns Office Representative
Head of Public Order and Safety Office (POSO)
Head of City Legal Office – Enforcement Unit
Bacolod City Health Officer
City Budget Officer
Head of Bacolod City Police Office
2 members from the Private Sector
1 member from the Business Sector engaged in chicken inasal business
President of the Manokan Country occupants/tenants

SECTION 5. Section 5 of the City Ordinance No. 482, Series of 2009, which reads:

“Section 5 – Funds: For the purpose of proper implementation and realization of the festival, the City Government through the Chief Executive shall provide a funding allocation to this yearly festivities in the amount not more than FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND PESOS (P500,000.00) subject for the approval of the Sangguniang Panlungsod. The funds shall be managed by the special committee and subject to liquidation based on the proper accounting and auditing procedures.”

Shall be amended to read as:

“FUNDS. For the purpose of proper implementation and realization of the festival, the City Government through the Local Chief Executive shall provide a funding allocation to this yearly festivity in the amount of Two Million Pesos (P2,000,000.00) subject for the approval of the Sangguniang Panlungsod. The funds shall be managed by the special committee and subject to liquidation based on the proper accounting and auditing procedures.”


SECTION 6. ANNUAL CELEBRATION. The City of Bacolod shall celebrate the Bacolod Chicken Inasal Festival every first week of May.

SECTION 7. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE: This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval.


