**CITY ORDINANCE NO. 906
June 26, 2019**

**AN ORDINANCE GRANTING ADDITIONAL FRANCHISE FOR THE OPERATION OF
MOTORIZED TRICYCLE FOR HIRE ON VARIOUS ROUTES WITHIN THE TERRITORIAL
JURISDICTION OF THE CITY OF BACOLOD.**

WHEREAS, Article 3 Section 458(3)(vi) of the Local Government Code postulates that the Sangguniang Panlungsod has the power, duty and function subject to the guidelines prescribed by the Department of Transportation and Communications to regulate the operation of tricycles and grant franchises for the operation thereof within the territorial jurisdiction of the city;

WHEREAS, Section 1 of City Ordinance No. 650 provides for the areas where motorized tricycles may be allowed to operate under an association, their respective terminals and the number of units allowed to ply within a specified route;

WHEREAS, City Ordinance No. 650 was enacted last 2013 and it is of public notice that there are new great developments, rise of establishments, schools and subdivisions, and increase in population in the City of Bacolod;

WHEREAS, motorized tricycle is the most convenient and fastest means that commuters will immediately be provided with public transportation;

WHEREAS, in order to cater these developments and the transportation needs of the people of Bacolod, it is necessary to establish new terminals and routes for which motorized tricycles may offer their services;

WHEREAS, the City of Bacolod through the Sangguniang Panlungsod has received several request letters from schools, barangay officials, homeowner's associations and motorized tricycle for hire associations for establishment of new terminals and routes to serve their community or constituents.

Section 1. GRANT OF ADDITIONAL FRANCHISES FOR NEW ROUTES

Apart from existing routes and terminals for motorized tricycle for hire under City Ordinance No. 650, new routes shall be created with their corresponding number of units and terminals as stated hereunder, to wit:

1. BARANGAY BATA

A. No. of Units : 30 Units

Terminal : Dead-end of Purok Kamunsil;



Route : From terminal to Bata Elementary School 1, Bata Elementary School 2, and Mormon Church, vice versa;

Association : Kamunsil Pag-isa Tricycle Operators and Drivers Association (KAPTODA);

2. BARANGAY CABUG

a. No. of Units : 60 Units;

Terminal : Bangga Purok Busay, Circumferential Road;

Route : From terminal to any point of Brgy. Cabug and back to terminal, OROLA Subd., CEGASCO to drop off passengers and back to terminal;

Association : Brgy. Cabug Busay Tricycle Operators and Drivers Association (BACABUSTODA);

3. BARANGAY FELISA

a. No. of Units : 40 Units;

Terminal : Bangga Totong, Brgy. Felisa;

Route : From Bangga Totong Terminal to Mansilingan Catholic Church, CEGASCO and back to terminal;

Association : Felisa Bangga Totong Tricycle Operators & Drivers Association Inc. (FEBATTODA);

4. BARANGAY MANSILINGAN

a. No. of Units : 50 Units

Terminal : Along Bacolod-Murcia Highway Junction Paglaum Entrance;

Route : From terminal to any point of Paglaum Village, Purok Manayaosayao, Purok Gonzaga, Purok Fortaleza, Purok Guanzon and back to terminal;

Association : Paglaum Village Tricycle Operators and Drivers Association (PVTODA);

5. BARANGAY TACULING

a. No. of Units : 30 Units

Terminal : 3rd Road, Circumferential Road;

- Route : From terminal to ACHHO Housing and Sea Oil Bangga Alijis only to drop off passengers and back to terminal without picking up of passengers;
- Association : Benedicto Marcos Tricycle Operators and Drivers Association (BMTODA);
- b. No. of Units : 50 Units;
- Terminal : St. Francis Avenue Corner Doña Juliana Drive;
- Route : Doña Juliana Subd., Sharina Heights, Las Palmas Subd., Lopues East to drop off passengers and back to terminal without picking up of passengers;
- Association : Bacolod-Taculing Tricycle Operators and Drivers Association (BATTODA);

6. BARANGAY VILLAMONTE

- a. No. of Units : 140 Units;
- Terminal : In front of Saint Joseph School entrance facing Villamonte Gym;
- Route : From terminal to any point of Brgy. Villamonte to drop off passengers and back to terminal;
- Association : Father Gratian Murray Tricycle Operators and Drivers Association (FGMTODA);
- b. No. of Units : 30 Units;
- Terminal : beside covered court AKISHOLA Village;
- Route : from terminal to any point of Brgy. Villamonte only to drop off passengers and back to terminal;
- Association : Villamonte AKISHOLA Tricycle Operators and Drivers Association (VILLAKITODA);

7. BARANGAY 7

- a. No. of Units : 25 units;
- Terminal : 17th Street BS Aquino Drive (beside Negros Grace Pharmacy);
- Route : from terminal to 15th Street Lacson and its interior roads but NOT to traverse Lacson Street, and vice versa;



Association : Magnolia Tricycle Operators and Drivers Association (MAGTODA);

8. BARANGAY 40

a. No. of Units : 35 Units;

Terminal : 10 meters away from Libertad Extension Margarita Avenue;

Route : From terminal to Brgy. 33, Sharina Heights and City Height only to drop off passenger and back to terminal;

Association : Margarita Tricycle Operators and Drivers Association (MARTODA);

Section 2. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE

Should any provision in this Ordinance or any part thereof be declared invalid or unconstitutional, the remaining provisions not affected shall continue in full force and effect.

Section 3. REPEALING CLAUSE

All existing ordinances, resolutions, executive orders or regulations and other issuances inconsistent with the provisions and/or purposes of this Ordinance are hereby repealed, amended or modified accordingly.

Section 4. EFFECTIVITY

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval in accordance with law.






