
RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE CITY VETERINARY'S OFFICE THROUGH THE HONORABLE MAYOR ALFREDO ABELARDO B. BENITEZ TO PROVIDE SUPPLIES TO THE BACOLOD CITY POUND SUCH AS FOOD FOR THE IMPOUNDED DOGS, WATER AND ELECTRICAL CONNECTION, AND OTHER NEEDS FOR THEIR OPERATIONS.

Upon motion of Councilor Celia Matea R. Flor, jointly seconded by Councilors Jude Thaddeus A. Sayson and Simplicia Z. Distrito, the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Bacolod

RESOLVED, to pass the following resolution:

WHEREAS, the Chairperson of the Committee on Markets and Slaughterhouse conducted a ocular visit to the Bacolod City pound and witnessed the current plight of the impounded dogs;

WHEREAS, Republic Act 8485 as amended by RA 10631 or the Animal Welfare Act of 1998 defines Animal Welfare as the physical and psychological well-being of animals. It includes, but not limited to, the avoidance of abuse, maltreatment, cruelty and exploitation of animals by humans by maintaining appropriate standards of accommodation, feeding and general care, the prevention and treatment of decease and the assurance of freedom from fear, distress, harassment, and unnecessary discomfort and pain, and allowing animals to express normal behavior;



WHEREAS, there are currently more than 90 impounded dogs and counting, most of which are weak and sickly, under the care of the Bacolod City Pound;

WHEREAS, the caretakers have expressed that as much as they would like to provide the best care, their current supplies will not allow it;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to request the City Veterinary's Office through the Honorable Mayor Alfredo Abelardo B. Benitez to provide the Bacolod City Pound immediate needs such as food for the impounded dogs, water and electrical connection, and other needs for their operations.
