RESOLUTION NO. 899

RESOLUTION URGING THE CITY HEALTH OFFICE THROUGH THE OFFICE OF THE CITY MAYOR TO IMPLEMENT CITY ORDINANCE NO. 586 OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE ANTI-BREAST CANCER CAMPAIGN ORDINANCE, IN CELEBRATION OF BREAST CANCER AWARENESS MONTH THIS OCTOBER.



Upon motion of Councilor Em L. Ang, jointly seconded by Councilors Celia Matea R. Flor and Simplicia Z. Distrito, the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Bacolod

RESOLVED, to pass the following resolution:

WHEREAS, Section 15, Article II of the 1987 Philippine Constitution provides that, "The State shall protect and promote the right to health of the people and instill health consciousness among them";

WHEREAS, City Ordinance No. 586 was passed last April 3, 2012 with the purpose of raising the awareness of Bacolodnons to the said disease by conducting information and education campaign programs regarding the prevention and early detection of Breast Cancer;

WHEREAS, the World Health Organization has declared October as the National Breast Cancer Awareness Month to specifically to increase awareness about the early detection of breast cancer and its prevention;

WHEREAS, the aforesaid ordinance has funding of One Hundred Thousand Pesos (P100,000.00) which the City Health Office may be able to use in their IEC programs and other activities in celebrating Breast Cancer Awareness Month;

WHEREAS, as per the 2021 data of the World Health Organization, there were about 2.3 million women diagnosed with breast cancer and 685,000 deaths globally;

WHEREAS, the Philippines is considered the country with the highest prevalence in Southeast Asia and ninth in the world with 27,163 cases and 9,926 deaths last 2021;

WHEREAS, the incidence of Breast Cancer in the Philippines is Thirty-two (32) per One Hundred Thousand (100,000), Forty-three (43) per One Hundred Thousand (100,000) in Asia while in Bacolod City is Forty-seven (47) per One Hundred Thousand (100,000);

WHEREAS, in a study conducted by Project BRIDGE of Roche International, the incidence of Breast Cancer in Bacolod City is the highest in the Philippines and among the highest in Asia;

WHEREAS, only one (1) in five (5) of newly-diagnosed Breast Cancer patients avail of routine laboratory predictive markers that guide treatment decisions;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlungsod deems it important to continue and maintain the awareness campaign program of the City Government to minimize the incidence of Breast Cancer among Bacolodnons and increase the chance of treatment through early detection of the said disease;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to urge the City Health Office through the Office of the City Mayor to implement City Ordinance No. 586 otherwise known as the Anti-Breast Cancer Campaign Ordinance, in celebration of Breast Cancer Awareness Month this October.
