



CITY ORDINANCE NO. 297

May 9, 2002

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING ALL UNIFORMED PHILIPPINE NATIONAL POLICE (PNP) PERSONNEL SECURING CLEARANCE FROM THE PEOPLE'S LAW ENFORCEMENT BOARD (PLEB) TO PAY A FEE OF TWENTY PESOS (PhP20.00) AT THE CITY TREASURER'S OFFICE AND BE OFFICIALLY RECEIPTED FOR THE SAME.

WHEREAS, by virtue of National Police Commission (NAPOLCOM) Memorandum Circular No. 91-002 (as amended, dated April 8, 1991), the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Bacolod City has created the local People's Enforcement Board (PLEB) mandated to hear and adjudicate all administrative complaints formally file by citizens, or by PNP men themselves in their private capacity, against erring PNP personnel;

WHEREAS, in the exercise of its functions, the People's Law Enforcement Board (PLEB) is empowered to litigate administrative complaints of the following nature: neglect of duty; irregularity in the performance of duty; misconduct; incompetency; oppression; dishonesty; disloyalty to the government; and violation of law;

WHEREAS, dictated by the outcome of administrative cases, PLEB may impose the following penalties: withholding of privileges; restriction to specified limits; suspension; forfeiture of salary or fine; demotion; and dismissal:

WHEREAS, unresolved PLEB cases, as well as unserved penalties, are impediments to favorable Personnel Actions within the PNP organization;

WHEREAS, in view of stated premises, PLEB Clearance is a requirement in effecting favorable PNP Personnel Action which includes but not limited to: schooling; training; loan (salary, AFPSLAI); change of status; change of assignment; transfer of station; lateral entry; promotion; reinstatement; and retirement (optional, forced);

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Bacolod, that:

Section 1 - Name: This ordinance shall be called "PLEB CLEARANCE FEE"

Section 2 - Obligation: It shall be required of all PNP uniformed personnel to settle the amount of Twenty Pesos (P20.00) Clearance Fee with the City Treasurer's Office before securing needed "PLEB" Clearance from PLEB Office upon presentation of an Official Receipt.

Section 3 - Effect of Failure: Failure to secure PLEB clearance would cause deferment of any impending favorable personnel action.

Section 4 - Enforcement: Compliance to this Ordinance shall be under the responsibility of PLEB Staff and payment of required fees to the City Treasurer's Office.

Section 5 - Separability and Effectivity Clause: Any section declared infirmed or unconstitutional shall not affect the validity of other sections. This ordinance shall take effect Thirty (30) days from its publication in a newspaper of local circulation.
