



**CITY ORDINANCE NO. 351**

**December 11, 2003**

**AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE COUNCIL OF COASTAL BARANGAYS (CCB) OF BACOLOD CITY, PROVIDING FOR ITS PURPOSES, COMPOSITION AND FUNCTIONS AND PROVIDING FUNDS THEREFOR.**

**WHEREAS**, of the sixty one (61) barangays of Bacolod City, fifteen (15) are coastal barangays or are barangays with portions of their territories being coastal, either by nature or by reclamation,

**WHEREAS**, coastal barangays have distinct and unique needs and concerns not present of felt by other barangays;

**WHEREAS**, in the planning and implementation of programs for the rehabilitation, preservation, utilization and development of the coastal resources and territories of the City of Bacolod, there is a need for integration, coordination, consultation and cohesion;

**WHEREAS**, a special council composed of coastal barangays of the City will greatly help in the achievement of the foregoing intents and purposes.

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Bacolod, that

**Article 1. Creation.** There is hereby created a special council in the City of Bacolod to be known as the **COUNCIL OF COASTAL BARANGAYS (CCB) OF BACOLOD CITY**, with member-barangays as follows:

Barangay Banago, 1, 2, 8, 10, 12, 13, 14, 16, 35, Singcang-Airport, Tangub, Pahanocoy, Punta-Taytay, and Sum-ag.

**Article 2. Statement of Purpose and Function; Coastal Management Plan.** The said Council shall exist and function for the purpose of integrating, coordinating, and harmonizing the plans and programs for their respective coastal areas and resources. As such, they shall have their respective coastal management plans, to be integrated into one coastal management plan for the city, which ensures that the different coastal management plans of the respective coastal barangays do not have cross-purposes with that of the others and of the City, and that there is cohesiveness in the whole coastal plans and programs of the local government. The City Coastal Management Plan shall have the following areas of concern, among others:

- a. Integrated coastal environmental protection and promotion, including coastal, aquatic and fisheries resources;
- b. Integrated eco-tourism for the whole coastal area of Bacolod City
- c. Integrated coastal solid waste management and environmental protection

- d. integrated coastal livelihood programs
- e. integrated coastal urban planning
- f. income generation using coastal resources
- g. research and capability-building
- h. integrated coastal or shoreline security
- i. other purposes germane and consistent with the foregoing

**Article 3. Composition of the Council.** This special council shall be composed as follows:

Chair	City Mayor
Members	The Puring Barangays of the 15 barangays mentioned in Article 1 hereof.

**Article 4. Special Advisory Board to the Council.** To guide the Council in the formulation of the integrated coastal management plan as required in this ordinance, the following shall serve as Special Advisory Board to the same:

CFARMC Chairman  
City Tourism Office  
CPDO  
ENRO  
Representative of Dept. of Agriculture and Fisheries  
Representative of the DENR (CENRO)  
Liga ng mga Barangay President

**Article 5. Submission of the Annual Barangay Coastal Management Plan and Annual City Coastal Management Plan.** Each barangay shall submit its own annual coastal management plan to the CCB on or before March 15 of every year. The CCB shall then integrate the same into one Coastal Management Plan for Bacolod City.

**Article 6. Meetings.** The Council shall meet at least quarterly, or as often as needed. It shall adopt its own rules, otherwise, it shall decide by simple consensus or majority rule, a quorum being present, the Chairman voting only to break a tie.

**Article 7. Prior Favorable Resolution or endorsement of the CFARMC.** The coastal management plan of the barangay as well as that of the city shall have the prior favorable endorsement of the Fisheries and Aquatic Resources Management Council (FARMC) of the barangay and the city respectively, which endorsement is a condition sine qua non to approval and/or funding of coastal management plans. There shall be continued coordination with the CFARMC in program execution and implementation.

**Article 8. Funding.**

**Section 1. Initial Funding.** In order to commence the stated purposes and functions of the Council as stated in this Ordinance, there is hereby set aside the initial amount of One Million Pesos (P1M) for the Council, to be taken from any available amount of the general fund, beginning with budget year 2004, to be augmented as may be necessary.

**Section 2. Compliance with City Ordinance No. 321, S of 2002** The programs to be funded pursuant to this ordinance shall comply with the requirements of City Ordinance 321, Series of 2002, "An ordinance setting the ceiling of personnel component of all project funds with personnel component under non-office expenditure of the 20% development fund at 30% per approved budget"

**Article 9. Effectivity** This ordinance takes effect immediately upon approval hereof according to law

**Article 10. Separability Clause** Should any part of this ordinance be declared by competent authority to be null and void, the remainder not so affected shall remain in force and effect
