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CITY ORDINANCE NO. 366

March 11, 2004

AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE BARANGAY DEVELOPMENT FUND FROM THE 20% DEVELOPMENT FUND ESTABLISHING ITS ALLOCATION USAGE AND IMPLEMENTATION.

WHEREAS, the Annual Budget each year contained an amount equivalent to 20% of the Internal Revenue Allotment (IRA), commonly known as the 20% Development Fund;

WHEREAS, part of the fund has been allocated for Barangay Development, the latest of which grants Php 300,000.00 for each urban barangay and Php 400,000.00 for each and/chartered barangay;

WHEREAS, such a system discriminates against barangays with larger population, problems and concerns;

WHEREAS, to rationalize the allocation to the different barangays it is necessary to establish a system where funds are extended considering its constituency.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Bacolod in regular session assembled that:

Section 1 – TITLE : This ordinance shall be known as the “Barangay Development Fund”.

Section 2- ESTABLISHMENT OF FUND. There shall be designated a portion of not less than 20% in the 20% Development Fund of each Fiscal Year for purposes of extending infrastructure and other development projects to all barangays in Bacolod City to be known as “Barangay Development Fund”.

Section 3- ALLOCATION OF FUND: The Barangay Development Fund for each Fiscal Year shall be allocated to all barangays in a ratio-proportion manner based on population or constituency, provided that the smallest barangay should have an allocation of not less than Php 100,000.00.

Section 4 – USAGE OF FUND: The Barangay Development Fund shall first be used mainly for infrastructure projects and then on other development projects as allowed by DILG and DEM guidelines on the use of the 20% Development Fund, provided that allocation for Personnel services conforms to limitations set by City Ordinance No. 321, Series of

Section 5 – IDENTIFICATION OF PROJECTS: Infrastructure projects and other development projects identified in the Barangay Development Plan, consistent with the City Development Plan, as attested to the CPDO and approved by the SP shall have priority in implementation from the Barangay Development Fund.

However, should the City Development Council or the Sangguniang Panlungsod deem otherwise, projects with over-riding public interest shall have priority.

Section 6- IMPLEMENTATION: Infrastructure projects approved by the City Development Council (CDC) and Sangguniang Panlungsod which will be funded from Barangay Development Fund shall be implemented by the City Engineer's Office. The labor/personnel component for each project shall be taken from the Barangay concerned unless public interest requires otherwise.

Implementation of projects shall be initiated on the year the AIP was approved by the Sangguniang Panlungsod.

The City Government may use the Barangay Development Fund of a barangay or barangays on infrastructure projects which will benefit the city at large, where said barangay or barangays will have a primary and direct benefit from such projects.

Section 7- REPORT: The City Engineer's Office shall make a status report, copy furnished the Sangguniang Panlungsod of projects implemented under this ordinance.

Section 8- IMPLEMENTING RULES: The City Mayor, may for the purpose of efficiency & clarity, formulate, issue & implement such Implementing Rules and Regulations to effect this Ordinance, within 30 days from passage of this ordinance, subject to the approval of and ratification by the Sangguniang Panlungsod.

Section 9- EFFECTIVITY: This ordinance takes effect upon its approval.


