CITY ORDINANCE NO. 389

May 5, 2005

AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE INTEGRATED COMMUNITY-BASED INFORMATION SYSTEM IN THE CITY OF BACOLOD AND PROVIDING FUNDS THEREFOR.

WHEREAS, the City of Bacolod as a highly urbanized city demands a streamlined information system that will contribute in establishing a tangible and efficient information system and ensure methodical measures for data gathering and banking;

WHEREAS, the fundamental concern of this ordinance is to update the City Government of the population status of the City of Bacolod as far as social and economic factors are concerned and finding solutions to problems emanating from such;

WHEREAS, the consolidation of information thru an integrated system will provide significant, accurate and accessible information necessary for the City Council, Local Chief Executive and other agencies concerned in creating suitable programs and projects for city development.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Bacolod that:

TITLE

AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE INTEGRATED COMMUNITY-BASED INFORMATION SYSTEM IN THE CITY OF BACOLOD.

It shall also be known for its short title as the Integrated Community-Based Information System (ICBIS).

Section 1 - Definition of Terms

Integrated Community-Based Information System (ICBIS) - a system consolidating all pertinent community-based information as basis for project and program planning and implementation. Such information will derive from local government agencies concerned for the full efficiency of the system.

Community-Based information - are details or data collated from all barangays in the City of Bacolod.

Section 2 - Local Agencies

The following are agencies required to be part of ICBIS:

1. City Planning Development Office (CPDO)
2. City Population Office

3. Public Affairs Assistance Office (PAAD)
4. Liga ng mga Barangay/ABC
5. Department of Social Services and Development (DSSD)
6. City Health Office (CHO)
7. Bacolod Housing Authority (BHA)
8. Bureau of Immigration and Deportation (BID)
9. City Tourism Office
10. Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH)
11. Bacolod City Police Office
12. Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG)
13. City Engineer's Office (CEO)
14. COMELEC/NSO
15. Urban Basic Services Office (for Nutrition Program)

Section 3 - Objectives

The objectives of the Integrated Community-Based Information System (ICBIS) shall be as follows:

1. To collate and provide information as to the status of the existing situation of each barangays in the City of Bacolod;
2. To study each barangay's population growth, profile and local socio-economic status;
3. To monitor the coming in and going out of migrants in the city and to notify the concerned Punong Barangay, within 24 hours, as to the putting up of houses by such;
4. To enlist every person or family member of migrants living in the barangay and have it stored for monitoring purposes;
5. To provide an accurate monthly report and update to the Sangguniang Panlungsod and the City Mayor for evaluation;
6. To generate evaluations and constitute recommendations for project and program planning and implementation;
7. To formulate a well-defined and efficient methodology of gathering and assessing information by an integrated effort among the agencies concerned that will strengthen and reinforce the efficacy of the information system;
8. To avail of the technical services, assistance and support of the Management Information Technology and Computer Services Department (MITCS) in carrying out the objectives of these ordinance



Section 4 - Specific Provisions

1. The City Planning and Development Office (CPDO) shall be the over-all coordinating agency responsible for the integration and demarcation of all gathered information.
2. All concerned agencies are compelled to submit their monthly reports on information relative to their fields
3. The City Planning and Development Office (CPDO), being the over-all coordinating agency, shall ensure other agencies concerned of proper orientation and training for an effective data gathering
4. The Office of the Liga ng mga Barangay, as the agency solely responsible for the proper coordination in each barangay shall warrant the full cooperation of all Punong Barangays in the City of Bacolod.
5. The concerned agencies shall include in their monthly report their assessments and evaluations for possible consideration in project and program planning.
6. The City Planning and Development Office (CPDO) shall consolidate all information, assessments and evaluations from the different agencies and furnish copies of its recommended projects and programs to the Sangguniang Panlungsod and the City Mayor.
7. Each Barangay should have at least One (1) ICBIS Coordinator who shall undergo proper basic orientation and training pertaining to his/her functions and responsibilities

Section 5 - Scope and Limitations

- City Planning Development Office

As the lead agency in supervising all the other agencies involved, the CPDO shall ensure a methodical gathering of socio-economic information from the different barangays for an accurate and comprehensive demographic presentation. As for the accessibility of data to other agencies, the CPDO must ensure that the acquisition of the information conforms to the bounds of legality and confidentiality and will not in any way intrude nor affect the privacy and constitutional rights of individuals

- Other Local Agencies

The local agencies involved in the information system must ensure a factual gathering of data using a systematic process for a legitimate sourcing of information for project and program planning. For the local agencies to avail of the information from the City Planning Development Office, the agency involved must secure a written consent from its Department Head declaring the purpose and limiting only to such.



All agencies of government but not limited to the DILG working towards collating the same community-based information under this ordinance are encouraged to coordinate an open area of partnership with the City of Bacolod to improve the system

Section 6 - Budget

- Budget necessary to fund the operations of this Ordinance shall be taken from one (1) percent of the twenty (20) percent Development Fund and is to be appropriated annually for the first two (2) years and shall thereafter be subject for review, depending on the necessity

Section 7 - Separability Clause

- Any provision declared illegal or unconstitutional by competent authority shall not in any way affect the other provisions not so declared and shall continue to be in full force and effect.

Section 8 - Effectivity Clause

- This ordinance shall be effective upon approval
