CITY ORDINANCE NO. 409
August 24, 2006

AN ORDINANCE NAMING THE ROAD FROM THE JUNCTION OF THE BACOLOD-MURCIA NATIONAL ROAD GOING TO PANAAD UP TO GRANDVILLE I SUBDIVISION IN MANSILINGAN, BACOLOD CITY, AS "ALBERTO ARCEO, SR. DRIVE."

WHEREAS, there was a request from the family of the late Alberto Arceo, Sr., docketed as SP Correspondence No. 05-187, to name the area from the junction of the Bacolod-Murcia National Road, originally known as Bangga Gemina, and later changed to Don Antonio Street, passing through the Home Development Corporation Subdivision (also known as Purok Mabinuligon) going to Panaad up to Grandville I Subdivision, Mansilingan, Bacolod City, as the Alberto Arceo, Sr. Drive;

WHEREAS, naming the said stretch of road as the "Alberto Arceo, Sr. Drive" would not only perpetuate the life, vision, and memory of the late Alberto Diaz Arceo, Sr., but it would likewise recognize his efforts, thru his family, of making their agricultural landholdings in Mansilingan Ilier, an area of growth and development not only for the City of Bacolod, but likewise for the Province of Negros Occidental;

WHEREAS, Alberto "Bert" Diaz Arceo, Sr. was born on May 11, 1911 to Sinfaroso Arceo and Cresencia Lacsamana Diaz in Victoria, Negros Occidental. He got married to Editha Villanueva Ramos in June 1940, and their union produced four children, namely: Alberto Jr., Armando, Basiliso, and Patricia Cuaycong;

In 1957, Mr. Arceo purchased from the family of Mr. Antonio Jayme, a 145-hectare property in Mansilingan, Bacolod City, which he planted with rice, sugarcane and vegetables.

WHEREAS, Mr. Albert Arceo Sr. was a hard worker, a disciplinarian, but at the same time a loving father and husband to his children and wife. He was loved by his farm workers and could never turn away anyone in need. He used to provide loans so that they could buy rice, fish or carabaos;

WHEREAS, on October 3, 1966, he, together with his wife, sons Alberto Jr. and Basiliso, while on the way to attend the birthday party of a relative and just a few meters from their house, were hit by a ten-wheeler truck. Mr. Arceo Sr. who was then driving was killed instantly while the rest survived;

WHEREAS, 40 years after Mr. Bert Arceo's death, the said farmland is now a thriving community. His family started Hillside Subdivision in 1976, Lasalleville in 1980. In 1997, the family sold 25 hectares to the Provincial Government for what is now the Panaad Sports Complex. Other subdivisions, namely, Grandville in 1999, and Forest Hills in 2002 soon followed. These subdivisions cover a total of 2,400 homes;

WHEREAS, the aforementioned road lot passes thru the vast landholdings of the Arceo Family and is therefore just and proper to name/rename the said road lot in the memory of the late Alberto Arceo, Sr.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Sangguniang Panglungsod in session:

Section 1. NAMING OF ALBERTO ARCEO SR., DRIVE

The road area from the junction of Bacolod-Murcia National Road passing through the Home Development Corporation Subdivision, now known as Purok Mabinuligon, going to the Panaad Sports Complex to Grandville I Subdivision, Mansilingan, Bacolod City, previously known as Don Antonio Street is hereby renamed and shall henceforth be known and called as Alberto Arceo, Sr. Drive

Section 2. REPEALING CLAUSE

All ordinances, resolutions and executive orders and other issuances which are inconsistent with any provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly

Section 3. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE

This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and approval thereof.

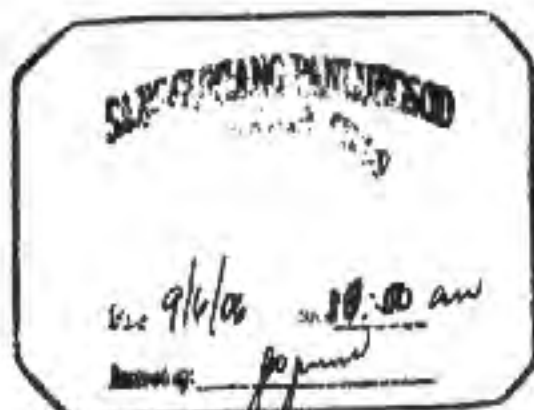
