CITY ORDINANCE NO. 450
October 31, 2007

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING PARAGRAPHS A AND B SECTION 3 OF CITY ORDINANCE NO. 1251, SERIES OF 1979, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS "AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE SALE OF LIQUOR, BEER OR OTHER INTOXICANTS TO PERSON OR PERSONS BELOW 18 YEARS OF AGE AND REQUIRING ALL REFRESHMENT PARLORS, EATING JOINTS, BARS AND OTHER SIMILAR PLACES WHERE LIQUOR, BEER AND OTHER INTOXICANTS ARE BEING SOLD OR DISPENSED, AND REQUIRING THE POSTING OF SIGNS AT LEAST THREE FEET IN WIDTH AND FOUR FEET IN LENGTH IN CONSPICUOUS PLACES TO THE EFFECT THAT "PERSONS BELOW 18 YEARS OF AGE ARE PROHIBITED TO TAKE OR DRINK LIQUOR, BEER AND OTHER INTOXICANTS", AND PROVIDING PENALTIES THEREOF.

WHEREAS, CO 1251 series of 1979 specifically the provisions in its penalties are no longer consistent with the present social condition and with the passage of time, Bacolod City as a highly urbanized city with population of almost half a million, and considering further the modern trend of living that affects the lives of our minors;

WHEREAS, in order to be more effective and socially-attuned with its implementation, there is an urgent need to amend certain provisions of said ordinance with emphasis on its penalties as provided.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE HONORABLE MEMBERS OF THE SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD OF BACOLOD CITY in session assembled that:

and so if amended, the same shall read as follows:

Section 3 – The owner or owners, manager or any persons in charge of a duly registered establishment serving such intoxicants to any person/s who is below 18 years of age shall be liable to the following penalties:

- a.) First Offense – suspension for one (1) month of the business establishment of its business permit, three months imprisonment and/or fine of P500 pesos or both at the discretion of the court against the owner/s or manager of the erring establishment.
- b.) Second Offense – revocation of BUSINESS PERMIT of the business establishment, an imprisonment of six (6) months and/or fine of P1000 pesos or both at the discretion of the court for the owner/s or manager or any person in charge of an erring establishment.

Section 4. Effectivity – This ordinance shall take effect fifteen (15) days after publication in a newspaper of local circulation..


