

CITY ORDINANCE NO. 475
December 17, 2008

AN ORDINANCE NAMING THE BARANGAY ROAD BESIDES THE CARLOS HILADO MEMORIAL STATE COLLEGE (CHMSC) IN BETWEEN CELINE HOMES SUBDIVISION AND CITYVILLE SUBDIVISION, LEADING TO PUROK PAG-ASA, FORTUNE TOWNE A AND B AND EAST HOMES SUBDIVISION AREAS TO BE NAMED AFTER THE LATE ROMAN TIONGKO MARAVILLA AND WILL KNOWN AS "ROMAN T. MARAVILLA AVENUE".

WHEREAS, SP Resolution No. 777, Series of 2008 dated and approved by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Bacolod City dated October 08, 2008 is intended to give due recognition to the "philanthropic foot prints" in the life of Roman Tiongko Maravilla for his noble generosity not only to the people of Barangay Estefania but to the entire neighboring community;

WHEREAS, the Barangay Council of Barangay Estefania in its regular session dated November 01, 2008, via Resolution No. BE 2008-063 and in response to SP Resolution No. 777, Series of 2008 also states "RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING TO THE SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD, BACOLOD CITY, THRU A CITY ORDINANCE THAT THE BARANGAY ROAD BESIDES THE CARLOS HILADO MEMORIAL STATE COLLEGE ((CHMSC) IN BETWEEN CELINE HOMES SUBDIVISION AND CITYVILLE SUBDIVISION, LEADING TO PUROK PAG-ASA, FORTUNE TOWNE A & B AND EAST HOMES SUBDIVISION AREAS WILL BE NAMED AFTER THE LATER ROMAN TIONGKO MARAVILLA AND WILL BE KNOWN AS "ROMAN T. MARAVILLA AVENUE".

WHEREAS, historical facts, records and relevant documents revealed that, in 1936 four (4) classroom classroom were provided by Roman R. Maravilla as primary school for children of workers of his hacienda to be educated. He hire four (4) teachers paid by him for the purpose. He later named Estefania Elementary School in a one (1) hectare property he also donated in honor of his aunt whose name was Doña Estefania;

WHEREAS, as a testimonial of his love and devotion to help the community, a road lot from Estefania Elementary School to Romanito Maravilla National High School was also donated by the Maravillas, and through him the Maravillas also donated two (2) hectares of land, the present site of the Romanito Maravilla National High School is situated;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Sangguniang Panlungsod Bacolod, that:



SECTION 1. - Title: The Barangay Road besides the Carlos Hilado Memorial State College (CHMSC) in between Celine Homes Subdivision and Cityville Subdivision, leading to Purok Pag-asa, Fortune Towne A & B and East Homes Subdivision areas will be named after the late Roman Tiongko Maravilla and will be known as "Roman T. Maravilla Avenue".

SECTION 2. - The City of Bacolod its appropriate line agencies and in cooperation with the Barangay Council of Barangay Estefania shall cause the processing of a commemorative marker, upon the approval of this ordinance inclusive with the period of days after publication and the above-mentioned areas shall be named "Roman T. Maravilla Avenue".


SECTION 3.- The City of Bacolod shall appropriate a budget commensurate to its implementation of more or less Forty Thousand Pesos (P40,000.00).


SECTION 4.- This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval and publication.
