## **HISTORICAL BACKGROUND**

Year 1972, after President Ferdinand Marcos declare Martial Law, Barangay 32, now as it has been called was formerly named according to the name of the streets commonly called MALALUSAN ZONE which stands for Mabini, Lacson, Luzuriaga, and San Sebastian.

Presidential Decree No. 557, declaring all barrios in the Philippines as Barangay on September 21, 1974 is the basis for the creation of Barangay 32.

Prior to the issuances of PD No. 557, the President promulgated PD No. 86 and 86-A which preceded PD No. 57. PD. 86 and 86-A created the citizen`s assembly and expanded the rights of the assembly membership to 15 years old among the assembly member.

On December 19, 1985, Hon. Jose Y. Montalbo Jr., then City Mayor of Bacolod City approved and adopted the delineation of boundaries of the Automotive Tubig Machine (ATM), Water Falls, Budge Computer Coffee, Hardy Marketing, Global Lending Corp., Demo Power, and Cargo and Logistic Corp.

- **ISSUES & CONCERNS:**

Maintenance of peace and order sense the barangay is surrounded by various commercial establishment, banks and other financial institutions.

- **INDUSTRY**

Barangay 32 has no handicraft or cottage industry.

- **AGRICULTURE**

Barangay 32 is a residential Barangay thus it doesn't engage in agriculture.

- **MEANS OF LIVELIHOOD**

Barangay 32 has no means of livelihood.

- **FORESTRY**

The Barangay has no forest land or even plant sales outlet share in other NGO/PO tree Planting Program.

Barangay32, supply and served by CENECO power, Ceneco office and feeders are walking distance only 200 meter from our Barangay 32, other residential and commercial Bldg. have their own generator in preparation for minimal power interruption.

Barangay 32, have cell site tower by GLOBE Telecom mostly 60% household used landline from PLDT facilities and 40% household used wireless phone or cellular phones.

- **CLIMATE**

The Barangay is none prone flood area especially during rainy seasons, it has good ambiance as well.

- **EDUCATION**

Barangay 32, considered as first subdivision in Bacolod City, (Dela Rama Subd.) and no resident school, But accessible for the different schools like Elementary School at Mabini, Secondary School ( NOHS), and different colleges, going south, UNO-R, going north, USLS, STI-WNU, SAC, RC, and other practical vocational school.

- **ISSUES AND CPONCERN:**

The Barangay has no Day Care Center which consider important for the early education and training of the Pre-School with parents who cannot afford to send their 3-4 old children to exclusive preschools.

- Lack of location for Barangay day care center.
- As per observation, the barangay 32, has minimal numbers of out of school youth which is mainly brought by the financial problems that leads to early employment of the youth.

- **PROGRAMS AND PROJECT:**

Thorough studies as to the location of the Day Care Center, as to the number of Preschoolers enrolled every year. How many pre-school it could help.

Assistance from the city is consider for the construction of the Day Care center if needed.

## **PROTECTIVE SERVICES**

Barangay 32, is under the jurisdiction of BAC-UP NHO. 1 with the coordination of barangay tanods, fortunately barangay 32, has minimal crime rate and zero incidence of fire. Our barangay is also adjacent to Chinese Chamber of commerce Fire Station located

at Shopping, Barangay 32 commercial building are guarded by security gfuards on a 24 hour basis.

Barangay 32, composed of four Puroks namely Purok Malalusan, Purok Tunay, Purok Brotherhood, and Purok progreso.

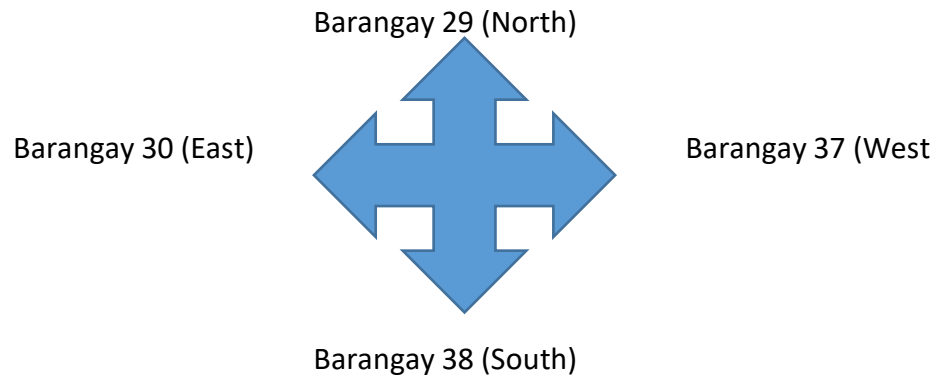

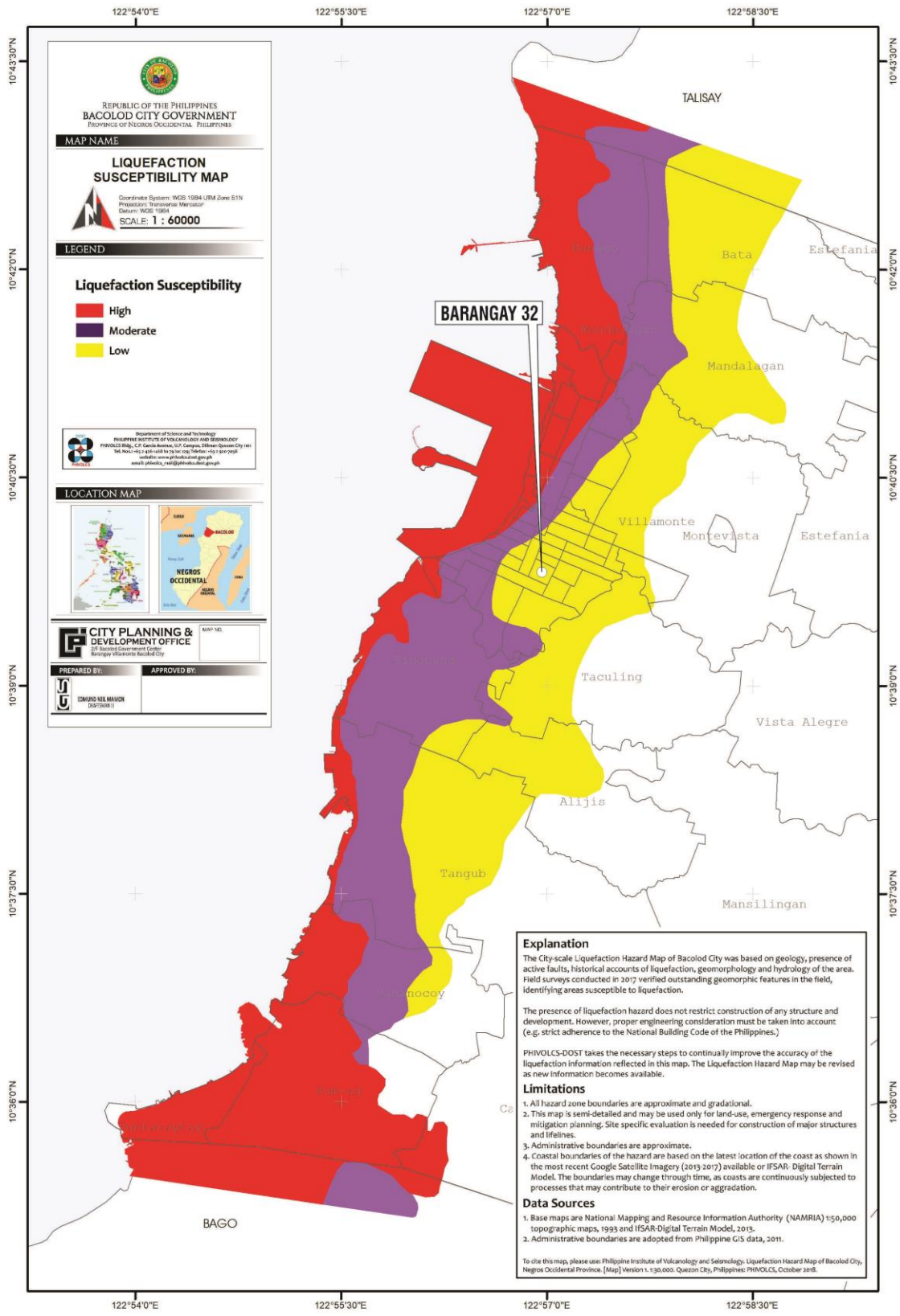

**Explanation**  
 The City-scale Liquefaction Hazard Map of Bacolod City was based on geology, presence of active faults, historical accounts of liquefaction, geomorphology and hydrology of the area. Field surveys conducted in 2017 verified outstanding geomorphic features in the field, identifying areas susceptible to liquefaction.  
 The presence of liquefaction hazard does not restrict construction of any structure and development. However, proper engineering consideration must be taken into account (e.g. strict adherence to the National Building Code of the Philippines.)  
 PHIVOLCS-DOST takes the necessary steps to continually improve the accuracy of the liquefaction information reflected in this map. The Liquefaction Hazard Map may be revised as new information becomes available.

**Limitations**  
 1. All hazard zone boundaries are approximate and gradational.  
 2. This map is semi-detailed and may be used only for land-use, emergency response and mitigation planning. Site specific evaluation is needed for construction of major structures and lifelines.  
 3. Administrative boundaries are approximate.  
 4. Coastal boundaries of the hazard are based on the latest location of the coast as shown in the most recent Google Satellite Imagery (2013-2017) available or IFSAR Digital Terrain Model. The boundaries may change through time, as coasts are continuously subjected to processes that may contribute to their erosion or aggradation.

 1. Base maps are National Mapping and Resource Information Authority (NAMRIA) 1:50,000 topographic maps, 1993 and IFSAR-Digital Terrain Model, 2013.  
 2. Administrative boundaries are adopted from Philippine GIS data, 2011.
