ORDINANCE NO. 71
Series of 1981

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 74, SERIES OF 1980 PRESCRIBING TUITION FEES IN THE BAKOLOD CITY PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOLS AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Bacolod, that:

Section 1 - Beginning with the school year 1980-1981, students enrolling in any public high school in Bacolod City shall be charged with a tuition fee in the amount of ONE HUNDRED TWENTY PESOS (P120.00) per school year, payable as follows:

Twelve Pesos (P12.00) upon enrollment and
Twelve Pesos (P12.00) monthly for the nine (9) succeeding months,
payable not later than the 6th of every month.

Section 2 - Section 2 is hereby amended to read, as follows:

The following however, are considered scholars of the City Government of Bacolod and shall enjoy free tuition:

a) Students whose parents or guardians have gross income not exceeding TEN THOUSAND PESOS (P10,000.00) annually. For this purpose, a sworn statement or an Income Tax Return by the parents or guardian on gross income shall be sufficient to determine whether or not a student shall be entitled to scholarship grant.

Section 3 - Students who are not qualified under Section 2 of this ordinance but have the qualifications hereunder stated are likewise considered scholars of the City Government of Bacolod, namely:

a) First and second honors who graduated from any elementary school in the City of Bacolod;

b) Two students with the highest average final scholastic ratings in the first, second and third years in any public high school in the City of Bacolod.

However, if there are Three Hundred (300) or more enrollees in any public high school for each year, Five (5) students shall be entitled to scholarship in each year.

Section 4 - Section 4 is hereby amended to read as follows:

If there are three (3) or more students from one and the same family, the eldest shall pay the amount stated under Section 1 hereof; the second, third, and so forth are likewise scholars of the City Government even if the income is more than TEN THOUSAND PESOS (P10,000.00).

Section 5 - Student applicant with a general scholastic average of 85% but not covered in any of the foregoing scholarship grants shall be required to pay half tuition fee or the amount of SIXTY PESOS (P60.00) to be paid in ten equal installments.

Section 6 - ~~Section 6~~ is hereby amended to read as follows:

Student applicant not covered in the above scholarship grants, whose grades and ratings in the vocational and practical arts course are 90 and above, shall likewise be considered full scholar of the City Government, if said student has no failure in the remaining subjects.

Section 7 - Any scholar who fails in any subject shall be charged a tuition fee for that subject in the amount of Five Pesos (P5.00) per unit subject upon re-enrollment, second repeater for the same subject shall be charged Ten Pesos (P10.00) per unit subject.

Section 8 - Outstanding accounts of all students as of the close of school year 1979-1980, are hereby restructured and shall be paid, as follows:

- a) Three Pesos (P3.00) per month starting the month of July, 1980 until the said account is fully paid. In case the account is more than Twenty-Seven Pesos (P27.00), the balance shall be carried to and paid during the succeeding school year in the installment amount starting the month both indicated above until fully paid.
- b) Report cards of students who may have graduated or who may transfer to other schools shall be released by the school principal concerned even if the student concerned has an outstanding account PROVIDED, that the parent executes a promissory note in line with the conditions in Section 8-a hereof.

Section 9 - Scholars entitled to the above grants must have graduated from any elementary school in the City of Bacolod or must have been enrolled in any city public high school during the school year 1979-1980 PROVIDED, however, that the parents or guardians of said scholars are bonafide residents of the City of Bacolod.

By bonafide resident is meant that the parents or guardians concerned must have actually resided in the City of Bacolod at least one year immediately prior to the passage of this Ordinance.

Section 10 - The City Mayor, however, upon concurrence of the City Superintendent of Schools may grant such other scholarships as he may deem wise and proper under the premises.

Section 11 - Penalty Clause: Parents or guardians who misrepresent their respective income shall be fined the sum of TWO HUNDRED PESOS (P200.00) and to pay the full tuition fee embodied under Section 1 hereof, or an imprisonment of not exceeding thirty (30) days and payment of tuition fees as required in Section 1, hereof in the discretion of the Court.

Section 12 - REPEALING CLAUSE. All ordinances or parts thereof inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 13 - This ordinance shall take effect upon approval.


