CITY ORDINANCE NO. 38^v
November 24, 1987

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE OPERATION OF VIDEO COMPUTER GAMES WITHIN THE CITY OF BACOLOD AND FIXING THE AMOUNT OF TAX TO BE COLLECTED BY THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF BACOLOD.

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Bacolod City in session assembled, that:

Section 1 - The term Video Computer Machines refers to a set consisting of a family computer complete with software and connected to a television set, which, in this ordinance, are rented out for a fee to customers within the City of Bacolod.

Section 2 - Said machine shall be registered with the Office of the City Treasurer of Bacolod and shall be charged a fee in the amount of ₱1.00 per machine, per day to be paid on a monthly basis subject to the following rules and regulations:

- a) That a fee of ₱1.00 per machine per day shall be imposed;
- b) That the permittee shall pay the said fee on the due date as determined by the City Treasurer upon registration of the said machine;
- c) That upon its registration the said machine shall be sealed by the Office of the City Treasurer;
- d) That failure on the part of the permittee to pay the said fee within five (5) days from due date shall immediately subject the said permittee to a surcharge of ₱50.00 per machine per day;
- e) That failure on the part of the permittee to pay the fee after the aforementioned 5-day period shall immediately subject the same to a fine of ₱1,000.00 and the cancellation of his business permit.

Section 3 - All Video Computer parlors, stores, shops and establishments engaged in the lease of said computer machines shall be located at least 100 meters away from the nearest boundaries of institutions of learning offering elementary, high school and collegiate education. All similar establishments located within the 100 meter radius shall be denied the necessary business permit and if said permit has already been issued, the same shall not be renewed.

Section 4 - Except on Saturdays, Sundays and non-working public holidays, Video Computer parlors, stores, shops and establishments engaged in the lease of the aforementioned machines shall be open to persons 16 years of age and below not earlier than 3:00 o'clock in the afternoon and not later than 7:00 o'clock in the evening. Any violation of these provisions shall immediately subject the permittee to a revocation of his business permit and a fine of ₱1,000.00.

Section 5 - All ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby modified or repealed.

Section 6 - This ordinance shall take effect 15 days from its publication upon its approval.




