CITY ORDINANCE NO. 55
December 6, 1988

AN ORDINANCE ALLOWING VENDORS TO SELL ALONG THE SIDE-
WALKS OF THE CITY OF BAKOLOD DURING THE PERIOD FROM DECEMBER 9,
1988 TO JANUARY 6, 1989, INCLUSIVE.

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Bacolod,
that:

Section 1 - Effective December 9, 1988 and up to and
including January 6, 1989, inclusive, vendors be permitted
to sell along the sidewalks of the City of Bacolod provided
that they shall sell only dry goods including traditional
Christmas items as fruits and others, except fish, vegetables
and meat and that in no way shall the selling along the side-
walks obstruct the passage of pedestrians and that the side-
walks shall always be kept clean and the installation of garbage
receptacles by the vendors concerned.

PROVIDED, FURTHER, that sidewalk vendors shall not obstruct
the door, entrance, or exit of any store, building or house in
order to give free passage to persons entering and leaving the
premises.

Section 2 - This ordinance takes effect December 9, 1988.





Gentlemen:

I am returning to the Sangguniang Panlungsod, City Ordinance No. 55 entitled "AN ORDINANCE ALLOWING VENDORS TO SELL ALONG THE SIDEWALK OF THE CITY OF BACOLOD DURING THE PERIOD FROM DECEMBER 9, 1988 TO JANUARY 6, 1989" without my signature and therefore the veto is hereby VETOED.

The reason for the veto is:

The Ordinance would be prejudicial to the general public welfare more particularly on the safety and convenience of the people who use the sidewalk. Without any alternative, they will spill out into the City streets if this Ordinance is approved.

Cognizant of the good intentions of the members of the Sangguniang Panlungsod and in the spirit of the Christmas season, we are recommending the following alternative:

1. All the spaces for car parking of the public plaza along Gonzaga and Gatalaga Streets.
2. Closure of Ballesteros Street from the portico after the Post Office and Prudential Bank.
3. Closure of Cuadra and Bonifacio Street.

These streets can be temporarily closed starting and ending on certain hours as the Sangguniang members deem advisable.

With the disapproval of the proposed City Ordinance No. 55 and the recommendation aforesaid, the members of the Sangguniang Panlungsod may readily observe that the undersigned is in agreement with the Sangguniang Panlungsod in providing for a place for the ambulant peddlers without prejudicing the interest of the general public.
