CITY ORDINANCE NO. 60 ✓
August 24, 1989

AN ORDINANCE NAMING THE BACOLOD CITY CIRCUMFERENTIAL ROAD AS THE "ALFREDO MONTELIBANO SR. AVENUE" IN HONOR OF THIS QUINTESSENTIAL BACOLEÑO.

WHEREAS, the Honorable Alfredo Montelibano Sr. was sworn in as the first Mayor of Bacolod during its City Charter Inauguration on October 19, 1938;

WHEREAS, during his stint as City Mayor, he was able to establish order in government, discipline among the citizenry and security of the general public thereby earning him the honor of being cited by President Manuel Quezon as a model Mayor;

WHEREAS, he displayed exemplary courage and patriotism by serving Negros and Siquijor Islands as Governor during the trying times of World War II, a period in our history when indeed our people were searching for bravery and dynamic leadership to steer them away from the dangers and miseries brought about by a cruel occupation;

WHEREAS, his vision and dynamism found him serving the national government in highly sensitive positions under four (4) Presidents of the Republic, namely: Secretary of National Defense and Interior under President Sergio Osmeña Sr., Chairman of the Import Control Commission under President Elpidio Quirino, Chairman of the National Economic Council under President Ramon Magsaysay and Chairman and General Manager of the Rice and Corn Administration under President Ferdinand Marcos;

WHEREAS, this Bacoleño also excelled as an industrialist, banker, economist, planter and miller, statesman, soldier, civic leader and philanthropist as shown by the awards and citations conferred upon him by the various sectors of our society in the local and national levels;

WHEREAS, in full recognition of his contributions to the nation, the institutions he founded and the ideas he turned to realities which have touched the lives of many, it is but fitting to honor and perpetuate the memory of this quintessential Bacoleño, who has joined his Creator on August 19, 1989, by naming a major street in the City of Bacolod after him.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Bacolod, in session assembled, that:

Section 1 - The Bacolod City Circumferential Road be hereby henceforth named "Alfredo Montelibano Sr. Avenue" in honor of this quintessential Bacoleño.

Section 2 - The delineation of the foregoing newly named street starts from the junction of Araneta Street in Barangay Phanocoy crossing through various streets up to junction of Cordova Boulevard, Barangay Banaga.

Section 3 - The City Engineer is hereby directed to post the corresponding street name on the areas affected and to make the necessary changes in the map of the City of Bacolod.

Section 4 - This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.


