CITY ORDINANCE NO. 62
December 7, 1989

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE ROUTE SYSTEM OF PUBLIC UTILITY VEHICLES AND TRUCKS, DEFINING THE LOADING AND UNLOADING ZONES IN THE CITY OF BACOLOD AND PROVIDING THE PENALTIES FOR ANY VIOLATION THEREOF.

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Bacolod City, that:

Section 1 - The route system of public utility vehicles and trucks and defining the loading and unloading zones in the City of Bacolod are hereby established.

ARTICLE I. ROUTES OF PUBLIC UTILITY VEHICLE

Section I-A. PUJs coming from the northern, southeastern area of Bacolod such as Bata, Mandalaan, Villamonta and others except Banaga, shall pass Lacson Street and shall execute a right turn to Rizal Street. Upon reaching Rizal-San Juan Streets, PUJs with passengers bound for the People's Market, shall pass thru the reclamation area, then turn left to Luzuriaga-San Juan Streets passing City Hall, Luzuriaga-Araneta Streets, Luzuriaga-Gatuslao and shall execute a right turn to Locsin Street and upon reaching Locsin-Hernaez Streets, shall turn left to Hernaez Street to Libertad Market or a right turn to Araneta Street passing thru San Sebastian Street, Rosario Street and a left turn at Hernaez Street to Libertad Market.

I-B. PUJs executing a left turn from Rizal-San Juan Streets upon reaching San Juan-Gonzaga Streets shall turn left thru Gonzaga Street, PUJs with passengers bound for City Hall, Lopez's, Rizal Elementary School, ETCS I and II, shall turn right to Araneta Street passing thru Luzuriaga Street, San Sebastian-Rosario Streets and shall turn left to Hernaez Street to Libertad Market.

I-C. PUJs having passengers for Central Market and GALSAN Department Store shall turn right to Gatuslao Street and are prohibited from making a right turn in the intersections of Luzuriaga-Gatuslao, Gatuslao-San Sebastian, Gatuslao-Rosario Streets and shall turn left to Hernaez Street to Libertad Market.

I-D. Upon reaching the junction of Mabini Street, the following shall be declared one way streets:

- 1) From Hernaez-Mabini Streets to Mabini-Margarita Streets one way going to the south direction;
- 2) From Margarita-Mabini Streets going to Margarita-Amelia Streets one way going to the east direction;
- 3) From Amelia-Margarita Streets to Hernaez-Amelia Streets one way going to the north direction;
- 4) From Hernaez-Amelia to Mabini Streets one way going to the west direction;

5) From Araneta-San Sebastian Streets to San

Sebastian Gatuslao Streets one way going
to the east direction;

- 6) From Araneta-Rosario Streets to Rosario-Loocsin Streets one way towards the east for PUJs only.

I-E. PUJs coming from Libertad Market are divided into three (3) ways:

- I-E. 1. Bata PUJs, Mandalagan and Banago passing Hernandez, shall execute a right turn to Araneta Street, then a right turn to Gonzaga Street, then turn left to Gatuslao Street. Upon reaching Rizal-Gatuslao Streets, Bata-Mandalagan vehicles shall again turn right to Rizal Street and upon reaching Rizal-Loocsin, shall turn left to Loocsin passing thru Ballo a right turn to Burgos Street and then a left turn to Lacson to destination.
- I-E. 2. Banago PUJs shall pass Gatuslao Street but are prohibited to make a right turn to Nueva Galo Streets and Burgos Street.
- I-E. 3. Shopping PUJs and others, except Bata, Banago and Mandalagan PUJs shall turn right to Loocsin Street then to Rizal-Loocsin and are not allowed to turn left in the intersections of Loocsin-Rosario Streets, Loocsin-San Sebastian Streets, Loocsin-Luzuriaga Streets, Loocsin-Gonzaga Streets and Loocsin-Cuadra Streets. Upon reaching Rizal-Loocsin Streets, they shall turn right towards Lacson Street then from Rizal-Lacson Streets shall turn left to Lacson Street and shall turn right either at Ballo or Burgos Street to destination.
- I-E. 4. PUJs coming from the Central Market to Helvetia Heights and DMCC shall pass thru Gonzaga Street, passing thru Lacson Street and shall either turn left and upon reaching Mabini shall turn right at Galo Street or pass Mabini Street making a left turn towards Lopez-Jaena and then turn right towards Burgos Street and vice-versa.
- I-E. 5. PUJs coming from the southern part of the City (Tanque, Sun-ag, Taloc, Punta Taytay, Airport, Magsungay, etc.) shall pass Araneta Street and shall pass the routes corresponding to their franchises from point of origin to point of destination.
- I-E. 6. Banago PUJs coming from Banago proper going to Shopping shall pass Aquino Drive to Shopping and vice-versa.

ARTICLE II. ROUTES OF TRUCKS

II-A - All trucks coming from the northern part of Bacolod going towards the reclamation area

shall pass thru Lacson Street then turn right to Aquino Drive. Upon reaching San Juan Street it shall turn left passing San Juan Street and turn right to Burgos-San Juan Streets to the reclamation area and vice versa.

- II-B - All trucks coming from the southern part of the City of Bacolod going towards the reclamation area using Araneta Street shall pass Araneta Street, then turn left to Alunan Street then make a right turn to Yulo Street, then make a right turn to Rosario Street, then turn left to San Juan Street and a left turn to Luzuriaga Street to the reclamation area and vice-versa.
- II-C - All trucks coming from Granada area to the reclamation area using Burgos Street shall turn left to Lopez-Jaena Street. Upon reaching Galo-Lopez Jaena Streets it shall execute a right turn to Galo Street going straight to San Juan Street. Upon reaching San Juan Street it shall turn right to San Juan Street and upon reaching Burgos Street shall turn left to the reclamation area and vice-versa.
- II-D - All trucks coming from the North going towards the South passing Bacolod from Lacson Street shall turn left to Aquino Drive up to Burgos Street, then turn left to Burgos then turn right to the A. Montelibano, Sr. Boulevard. If they are proceeding to Araneta Street, turn right to Murcia-Airport Road; then somewhere at Goodyear, then turn left and proceed out of Bacolod. For destination towards Murcia and Don Salvador turn left to Murcia-Aliji's road then get out of Bacolod. The same routes shall apply to cargo trucks coming from the South, going to Bacolod or farther north.
- II-E - All trucks coming from the east such as Murcia and Don Salvador going to Bacolod and Reclamation Area, shall take the Murcia-Aliji's Road, then turn right upon reaching Montelibano Boulevard, then turn left Hernaiz Street, turn left Magsaysay Avenue it shall make a right turn using Magsaysay Avenue going to Araneta Street. Upon reaching Araneta Street it shall make a right turn to Araneta Street to its destination and vice-versa using the designated routes in II-B.

ARTICLE III. LOADING AND UNLOADING ZONES

- III-A - From Gonzaga-San Juan Streets to Gatuslao-Gonzaga Streets shall be provided with a designated loading and unloading zones on San Juan-Gonzaga Streets to Araneta-Gonzaga Streets while unloading zones on one side particularly South side of Gonzaga from Araneta to Gatuslan Street.
- III-B - From Gonzaga-Araneta Streets to Araneta-Hernaiz Streets shall be provided with designated loading and unloading zones on both sides.
- III-C - From Araneta-Hernaiz Streets to Hernaiz-Nabini

streets shall be provided with loading and unloading zones on both sides.

- III-D - From Lopez Jaena-Hernaez Streets to Hernaez-Mabini Streets shall be provided with loading and unloading zones on both sides.
- III-E - From Mabini-Hernaez Streets to Mabini-Margarita Streets shall be provided with loading and unloading zones on both sides.
- III-F - From Margarita-Amelia Streets to Amelia-Hernaez Streets shall be provided with loading and unloading zones on both sides.
- III-G - From Hernaez-Lacson Streets to Locsin-Rizal Streets shall be provided with loading and unloading zones on both sides.
- III-H - From Lacson-Rizal Streets to Rizal-San Juan Streets shall be provided with loading and unloading zones on both sides.
- III-I - The Traffic Division may designate other streets as loading and unloading zones in accordance with the trend of time for the good and convenience of the general public subject to the approval by the Sangguniang Panlungsod.

ARTICLE IV - DEFINITION OF TERMS

Section 1 - For purposes of this ordinance the following terms are defined:

- 1.2 - Trip cutting of "FOR HIRE" vehicles is the failure to reach their point of destination from their point of origin with or without passengers.
- 1.3 - Refuses to convey or carry passenger/s - Refusal to transport/convey passenger/s to their destination in consonance with their approved route.
- 1.4 - Out-of-route vehicle- operation of "FOR HIRE" vehicle outside its authorized line or approved route as stipulated in their franchise.
- 1.5 - Overcharging of fares more than the amount fixed by Law.
- 1.6 - Obstruction - stopping on any portion of the highway or street causing obstruction to the free flow of traffic.
- 1.7 - Ignoring traffic signs - disregarding or disrespecting of traffic signs.

ARTICLE V - PENALTY CLAUSE

Section 1 - Violation of this ordinance as follows:

- a. Trip cuttingP300.00
- b. Refusal or failure to convey passenger/sP300.00

- c. Out-of-route vehicleP500.00
- d. Overcharging of fareP100.00
- e. ObstructionP100.00
- f. Ignoring traffic signsP100.00
- g. Arrogance or discourtesy of drivers..P100.00
- h. Reckless driving-driving which endangers life and/or property.....P100.00
- i. Violations of any section or sections of Articles I - III shall be fined ONE HUNDRED PESOS (P100.00) each section violated and violations not specified above.

ARTICLE VI - REPEALING CLAUSE

Section 1 - Any ordinance or provisions thereof inconsistent with any provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed accordingly modified and/or repealed.

ARTICLE VII - SEPARABILITY CLAUSE

Section 1 - If any section of this ordinance is declared null and void, the other part not so declared shall remain valid and enforceable.

ARTICLE VIII - EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE

Section 1 - This ordinance shall take effect fifteen (15) days from the date of approval.


