CITY ORDINANCE NO. 68[✓]
September 27, 1990[✓]

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE SIZE OF CARGOES ON TRUCKS/
VEHICLES, PARTICULARLY ON THE WIDTH, LENGTH AND HEIGHT, WITHIN
THE CITY OF BACOLOD AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS
THEREOF.

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Bacolod, in
session assembled, that:

Section 1. All trucks/vehicles including their load such as
sugar cane, lumber, firewood, construction materials, garbage,
bagasse and other cargoes shall in no way extend over 2.5 meters
in width.

Section 2. Trucks/vehicles, similarly loaded as in the
preceding Section, shall be provided with any contraption to
hold the cargo from spilling over.

Section 3. The overhang of cargoes of trucks/vehicles,
shall not exceed 50% of the wheel base. The measurement of
this allowable 50% shall commence from the center of the rear
wheel.

Section 4. The provisions of Section 3 notwithstanding, in
cases where the cargoes are lumber, steel bars or such other
materials which are indivisible and naturally extend beyond the
rear of trucks/vehicles, extra warning devices shall be used
such as lights visible at least one hundred (100) meters away
during nighttime and visible red flaglets made of durable
materials, with a size of 30 cm x 30 cm, during day time.

Section 5. In no way shall taillights or extra warning
devices be covered in such a manner that hampers visibility.

Section 6. All trucks/vehicles, whether loaded or not,
shall not exceed the maximum height of 4.27 meters from the
ground.

Section 7. In cases where it is imperative to operate
trucks/vehicles beyond the coverage of any Section of this
Ordinance, the provisions of Article 2, Section 10 of Republic
Act 4136 may be applied in coordination with the local Traffic
Division of the INP Station.

Section 8. Violation of any provision of this Ordinance
shall be punishable by:

- A. A fine of not less than ₱300.00 but not more than
₱500.00 and/or imprisonment of not less than Three
(3) days but not more than Five (5) days on the
first offense.
- B. A fine of not less than ₱500.00 but not more than
₱800.00 and/or imprisonment of not less than Five
(5) days but not more than Eight (8) days on the
second offense.
- C. A fine of not less than ₱800.00 but not more than
₱1,000.00 and/or imprisonment of not less than
Eight (8) days but not more than Fifteen (15)

Section 9. All existing ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

Section 10. This Ordinance shall take effect Ten (10) days after its publication in a local newspaper.


