CITY ORDINANCE NO. 85
February 11, 1993

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING AND CREATING THE BACOLOD CITY SPORTS COUNCIL, ITS OBJECTIVES AND PURPOSES.

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Bacolod, that:

Section 1 - Title: This Ordinance shall be known and cited as the formal declaration and creation of the Bacolod City Sports Council.

Section 2 - Purposes: The Bacolod City Sports Council is created for the following purposes:

- a) To unite all existing and duly accredited sports associations, clubs, foundations, etc. in the City of Bacolod;
- b) To coordinate all sports activities in the City of Bacolod;
- c) To provide quality physical fitness programs;
- d) To organize, promote and support competitive leagues and tournaments for achievement and competence and other related activities in order to enhance the lives of the people in the communities regardless of creed, beliefs, physical and mental abilities as well as social and economic status in life.

Section 3 - Objectives: The Sports Council shall have the following objectives:

- a) Develop and aggressively promote and support sports leagues and tournaments and physical programs;
- b) Pursue a vigorous sports development program that recruits, trains, retains, retrain, and achieve expertise;
- c) To seek whatever appropriate, greater involvement as an advocate for sports;
- d) To work with people and other agencies and develop relationship that pertains to education, training, and to develop harmonious understanding;
- e) To attain the total development of man through programs conducted and services undertaken which are designed to contribute to character building, values education, habit formation, leadership training and conviction development.

Section 4 - Principles: As Sports Council, it shall be guided by the following declared principles:

- a) The Bacolod City Sports Council is an association of sports associations, institutions, agencies involved in sports, who are working together to improve the quality of life of people through sports and related activities under the Office of the City Mayor.

b) The delivery of programs and services are through the respective sports associations which have affiliated and signified willingness to abide by these guiding principles, purposes and objectives of the Bacolod City Sports Council.

c) To implement the policies adopted and formulated by the Executive Board which are necessary in order to avail of the city government's assistance: finance, manpower, facilities, etc.

d) The needs are assessed by the respective sports associations. The core strategies and development of programs and services to meet those needs is retained by the respective sports associations.

e) The programs, services of the sports associations are evaluated by the Executive Board of the Council, at least on annual basis, in terms of assessed needs and goals.

f) Collaboration and cooperation with the sports associations, institutions and agencies in order to attain the purpose, objectives and guiding principles is the ultimate goal of the Council.

Section 5 - Membership: Membership shall be open to all sports associations, clubs, foundations, etc. existing in the City of Bacolod duly accredited for the purpose and as determined and approved by the Executive Board.

Section 6 - Executive Board, Composition and Term of Office:

a) The Sports Council has for its highest body known as the Executive Board composed of fifteen (15) members, twelve (12) of whom shall be elected from among the Presidents of the member associations or their duly authorized representatives. The two (2) others who are not elected shall be represented by Sangguniang Panlungsod members, one (1) of whom shall be the Chairman of Committee on Youth and Sports who shall sit therein in an ex-officio capacity.

b) That the Board shall have an Executive Officer who is nominated by the Sangguniang Panlungsod from among themselves. Provided that the term of office of the Executive Officer is one year with re-election.

c) That the Honorable City Mayor shall sit in the Executive Board as Chairman.

d) The Executive Board Members except for the Chairman, Executive Officer, and the Chairman of the Committee on Youth and Sports of the Sangguniang Panlungsod shall have a term of Office of one (1) year with one re-election. It is understood that the members thereof, shall be elected annually in an election to be held in the month of February of every current year.

Section 7 - Duties and Responsibilities of the Executive Board:

a) It shall determine the future direction of the Sports Council.

b) It shall set the goals and objectives of the Sports Council.

c) It shall develop long range plans to achieve the goals and objectives of the Sports Council and submit the same for approval of the Sangguniang Panlungsod.

d) It shall promulgate such rules and regulations to govern leagues and tournaments held in the City of Bacolod.

Section 8 - Implementing Officers: For the purpose of carrying out the approved plans and programs of the Executive Board, there shall be Sports Commissioner and Coordinators who are tasked to implement policies adopted by the Council and give appropriate leadership to carry out the duties and responsibilities to help achieve the goals and objectives of the Council. Further, in order for the Sports Commissioner and Coordinator to function truly well, the Executive Board shall be authorized to create its Secretariat tasked to keep and maintain updated records of all sports events, leadership, awardees, etc.

Section 9 - Election of Implementing Officer: The Sports Commissioner and Coordinator shall be elected from among the members of the Executive Board and whose term is co-terminous with those of the members thereof. It is however understood that the Chairman of the Executive Board shall be ineligible for the positions of the Sports Commissioner and Coordinator.

Section 10 - Supervision: The Office of the City Mayor of Bacolod City shall exercise over-all control and supervision on the activities of the Bacolod City Sports Council.

Section 11 - Funds: The Sports Council can request for such funds as it may need to finance and undertake its various projects and activities geared toward the development of man, mentally, physically and spiritually from the city government.

Section 12 - Office: The Office of the Bacolod City Sports Council shall be at the office of the Chairman so designated.

Section 13 - Remuneration: All members of the Executive Board, Sports Commissioner as well as Coordinators shall render service without remuneration from the city government except when the Sangguniang Panlungsod shall provide for their minimum per diem through an Ordinance enacted for the purpose.

Section 14 - Effectivity: This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.




