

CITY ORDINANCE NO. 89

June 8, 1993

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER XXIV OF ORDINANCE NO. 110, SERIES OF 1956 AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. 1270, SERIES OF 1967 AND ORDINANCE NO. 2540, SERIES OF 1972 ENTITLED "PENALTIES".

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Bacolod, that:

CHAPTER XXIV

PENALTIES

Section 1 - Violations and Penalties. - The following penalties shall be imposed for violations of this Code by motor vehicles:

(a) x x x x x x x x .

(b) For failure to sign the chauffeur's license or its duplicate or to carry same while operating, One Hundred (P100.00) Pesos fine.

(c) For operation with a delinquent or invalid license, One Hundred (P100.00) Pesos fine.

(d) x x x x x x x x .

(e) For failure to stop in case of accident, Two Hundred (P200.00) Pesos fine.

(f) For operation of a motor vehicle without proper number plates or tags for the current year, One Hundred (P100.00) Pesos fine.

(g) For operation of a motor vehicle, with delinquent, suspended or invalid registration:

Driver, owner and operator, One Hundred (P100.00) Pesos fine for each.

(h) For operation of a motor vehicle by an unlicensed operator,

(h-1) Five Hundred (P500.00) Pesos for the first offense;

(h-2) Seven Hundred Fifty (P750.00) Pesos for the second offense; and

(h-3) One Thousand (P1,000.00) Pesos for the third and succeeding offenses.

(i) For operating a motor vehicle while under the influence of a liquor, a fine of not less than Two Hundred (P200.00) Pesos or more than Five Hundred (P500.00) Pesos.

(j) For using a private passenger automobile, private trucks, private motorcycles, and motor wheel attachments for hire in violation of Section 36, Chapter VII of this Code, a fine of

Two Hundred (P200.00) Pesos and suspension of the chauffeur's license for a period of three (3) months for the first conviction; and a fine of Four Hundred (P400.00) Pesos and six (6) months imprisonment for the second conviction; and an imprisonment of six (6) months and permanent revocation of the chauffeur's license for the third conviction, shall be imposed inclusive of fine in the amount of One Thousand (P1,000.00) Pesos.

(k) For permitting, allowing, consenting to, or tolerating the use of privately owned motor vehicles for hire in violation of Section 38, Chapter VII of this Code, there shall be imposed a fine of Two Hundred (P200.00) Pesos for the first conviction, and a fine of Four Hundred (P400.00) Pesos for the second and subsequent convictions.

(k-1) Persons violating the provisions of Section 3, Chapter IX hereof shall, upon conviction, be punished with a fine of Fifty (P50.00) Pesos, Philippine Currency plus imprisonment of one day in case of failure to pay the fine; 2nd offense, One Hundred Pesos (P100.00) plus 10 days imprisonment; for the third and succeeding offenses, Two Hundred Pesos (P200.00) plus imprisonment of 15 days.

(l) For violation of any provisions of this Code or regulations not herein before specifically punished, a fine of not less than Fifty (P50.00) Pesos or more than One Hundred (P100.00) Pesos shall be imposed.

Section 2 - Effectivity. This ordinance shall take effect upon approval.




