CITY ORDINANCE NO. 99
July 29, 1993

AN ORDINANCE RENAMING "6TH STREET, NARRA AVENUE, AND THE ROAD UP TO HERVIAS HIGH SCHOOL JUNCTION", BACOLOD CITY, TO INOCENCIO V. FERRER, SR. AVENUE IN HONOR OF THE LATE CONGRESSMAN AND SOCIAL SECURITY SYSTEM COMMISSIONER INOCENCIO V. FERRER, SR., ONE OF THE DISTINGUISHED AND ILLUSTRIOUS SONS OF BACOLOD.

WHEREAS, the Honorable Inocencio V. Ferrer, Sr. was Congressman of the 2nd District of Negros Occidental which included Bacolod City and served the district for two (2) consecutive terms;

WHEREAS, prior to his election as Congressman, he was able to distinctively serve and held office in Bacolod as Secretary to the late Mayor Teofisto Cordova;

WHEREAS, as Congressman of the 2nd District of Negros Occidental, he distinguished himself in the Halls of Congress of the Philippines by sponsoring and/or co-sponsoring bills which are approved into laws of national importance earning for himself the moniker "Sta. Claus of Labor";

WHEREAS, aside from his title given to him as Sta. Claus of Labor he had been honored and consecutively voted by the Philippine Free Press as one of the most outstanding Congressmen of the country during his entire stint of office;

WHEREAS, as member of the Social Security Commission he had been responsible for such remarkable policies which undoubtedly redounded to the benefit of both the employers and employees who constitute the staunchest pillars of the Social Security System of the country;

WHEREAS, in full and absolute recognition of his valuable contributions to the nation as well as the sterling ideas he translated to realities which have touched the lives of many of our Filipino brethren, it is but proper, fitting and in order to honor as well as perpetuate the memory of this son of Bacolod, who joined his Creator on August 12, 1984, by naming a major street in the City of Bacolod after him;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Bacolod, in session assembled that:

Section 1 - The 6th Street stretching to Narra Avenue, Shopping Center, and the road up to Hervias High School junction, be renamed and henceforth be known as "Inocencio V. Ferrer, Sr. Avenue" in honor and recognition of the late and former Congressman/SSS Commissioner Inocencio V. Ferrer, Sr., one of the illustrious and distinguished sons of Bacolod.

Section 2 - The City Engineer is hereby directed to post the corresponding street name therein and to effect the necessary change of such new street name in the map of the City of Bacolod.

Section 3 - That a copy of this Ordinance be sent to the National Historical Commission to form part of the historical records of the National Government.

Section 4 - Effectivity. This ordinance shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication.




