CITY ORDINANCE NO. 102
January 20, 1994

AN ORDINANCE FURTHER REGRANTING THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE TAX RELIEF UNDER CITY ORDINANCES NOS. 86 AND 101, BOTH SERIES OF 1993.

WHEREAS, under City Ordinance No. 86, Series of 1993 taxpayers of Bacolod City with real estate delinquency were given up to July 31, 1993 within which to settle their tax liabilities with a condonation of interests and penalties if the taxes are paid on the period above specified;

WHEREAS, the purpose of the tax relief Ordinance is to ease the present economic condition and to encourage tax payments to improve the coffers of the city by virtue of the expected increase in real estate tax revenue collection;

WHEREAS, the report on the availment of the tax relief Ordinance by the City Treasurer shows a very discouraging result because only few have availed of the tax relief Ordinance due to the adverse financial condition aggravated by the fact that the period from September are lean months in Bacolod City and the rest of the province;

WHEREAS, in order to attain the objective of City Ordinance No. 86, the Sangguniang Panlungsod extended the Tax Relief until December 31, 1993, under City Ordinance No. 101, Series of 1993 and to give allowance and/or extension to the taxpayers who are willing to avail of the City Ordinance but are presently unable to do so due to severe financial constraint and the devastations of crops and infrastructures brought about by the recent typhoon that struck Bacolod City, it is necessary to extend the efficacy of the Ordinance up to February 28, 1994.

WHEREAS, real property owners have sought for another regranting of the tax relief Ordinance until February 28, 1994 due to the devastation caused by typhoon Puring that hit Bacolod City last December 26, 1993 which prompted President Fidel V. Ramos to declare Bacolod City as a calamity area.

WHEREFORE, be it ordained by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Bacolod City, that:

Section 1 - The tax relief provided for under City Ordinances Nos. 86 and 101 be regranted to February 28, 1994 subject to the same conditions therein set forth.

Section 2 - This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval.
