CITY ORDINANCE NO. 148

AN ORDINANCE CHARGING A TEN PERCENT (10%) AMUSEMENT TAX ON THE CONCERT ENTITLED "SABOR LATINO" TO BE HELD ON NOVEMBER 29, 1995 AT THE ISLAND BALLROOM OF THE BACOLOD CONVENTION PLAZA HOTEL, THE PROCEEDS OF WHICH WILL BE FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE BACOLOD BOYS HOME AND FOR THE VICTIMS OF TYPHOON "PEPANG" AS CONTAINED IN THE LETTER OF MR. NICHOLAS VILLASOR LIZARES, PROJECT DIRECTOR, DOCKETED AS SP CORRESPONDENCE NO. 95-1695.

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Bacolod, that:

Section 1 - A Ten Percent (10%) amusement tax is hereby charged on the concert entitled "Sabor Latino" to be held on November 29, 1995 at the Island Ballroom of the Bacolod Convention Plaza Hotel, the proceeds of which will be for the benefit of the Bacolod Boys Home and for the victims of typhoon "Pepang" as contained in the letter of Mr. Nicholas Villasor Lizares, Project Director, docketed as SP Correspondence No. 95-1695.

Section 2 - That out of the ten percent (10%) amusement tax, 5% will be for the City and the other 5% will be for the victims of typhoon "Pepang".

Section 3 - This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.






