CITY ORDINANCE NO. 167
JUNE 13, 1996

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A FISH TERMINAL IN BACOLOD CITY OTHERWISE KNOWN AS "PALA-PALA". PRESCRIBING FEES AND PROVIDING PENALTIES THEREFOR.

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Bacolod, that:

WHEREAS, Bacolod City is the only highly urbanized city in the country without a fish terminal;

WHEREAS, Bacolod City previously operated a fish terminal in Barangay Banago, but it was temporarily transferred to the present fish terminal or "Pala-Pala" sometime in 1977 in order to rehabilitate the old and dilapidated buildings;

WHEREAS, the plan to rehabilitate the old Pala-Pala building did not materialize and so, until the present time, the said Fish Terminal Pala-Pala continues to be at its present location without any enabling ordinance or legal basis;

WHEREAS, there is a need to return and restore the Fish Terminal or Pala-Pala to Barangay Banago, where it is more accessible to fishermen, wholesalers, and retailers of marine products and also to the City Government of Bacolod to generate additional income;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD OF BACOLOD IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, THAT:

Section 1 - there is hereby created and established "The Bacolod Fish Terminal" popularly known as "Pala-Pala".

Section 2 - The "The Bacolod Fish Terminal"/Pala-Pala shall be located within the vicinity of Barangay Banago, Bacolod City particularly at the old Pala-Pala site.

Section 3 - That fish and or marine products coming from outside Bacolod City to be sold on wholesale shall be coursed through the said Bacolod Fish Terminal/Pala-Pala.

Section 4 - That the rates to be imposed on loading fees shall be a Monthly Rental of EIGHT THOUSAND PESOS (P8,000.00) only per month for every stall (98 square meters) occupied by the Fish Dealer Operators. The said monthly rental shall be paid within the first five (5) days of the following month. The rentals shall be increased at the rate of 10% annually on the 4th year of its operation.

Section 5 - Penalty: Violation of the payment of rentals for space within the prescribed period shall be subject to a surcharge of 20% plus an interest of 2% per month including surcharges until it is fully paid.

Section 6 - That the Office of the Honorable City Mayor is hereby authorized to promulgate the necessary rules and regulations to implement this Ordinance.

Section 7 - All ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are deemed repealed.

Section 8 - This Ordinance shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication.






