

CITY ORDINANCE NO. 195

November 25, 1997

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING A BACOLOD CITY SONG.

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Bacolod,
that:

Section 1. Title. - This ordinance shall be called the
Bacolod City Song Ordinance.

Section 2. Policy. - It is herein the policy of the
Bacolod City Government to create a unified, coordinated and
harmonious relations among its people as well as strong,
enduring and resolute spirit in them as Bacoleños by
instilling in them a common and familial sentiment towards
Bacolod City, its citizens and environment through the Bacolod
City Song.

Section 3. Official Song. - Bacolod City shall hereby
adopt an Official Bacolod City Song embellished with lyrical
and musical qualities reflective of its history, culture,
sentiments and vision as a people, as a home and as a
government.

Section 4. Appropriation. - There is hereby appropriated
a sum of THIRTY THOUSAND PESOS (P30,000.00) to be taken from
the item Extraordinary and Miscellaneous Expenses in the
current budget of the Office of the Sangguniang Panlungsod to
pay for the expenses of hiring the qualified musician and/or
lyricist who will compose the lyrics and music of the Bacolod
City Song as well as expenses for the dissemination of the
copies thereof to the City of Bacolod.

Section 5. Bacolod City Song Committee. - a) There is
hereby created a Bacolod City Song Committee to be chaired by
the Mayor with the following members:

1. a representative from the Sangguniang Panlungsod,
2. a representative from the Division of Public Schools
in the City,
3. a representative from the association of private
schools in the City,
4. three citizens of Bacolod City who are of reputed
competence in music.

b) All the foregoing members shall be appointed by the
Mayor except the representative of the Sangguniang Panlungsod
who shall be selected by the members thereof from among
themselves.

c) The Committee shall:

1. decide their schedule of meetings,
2. select the appropriate musician and/or lyricist who will compose the music and the lyrics of the Bacolod City Song,
3. deliberate on the suitability, acceptability, aptness, soundness, quality and character of the lyrics and music of the song, and
4. submit and recommend the final draft of the song to the Sangguniang Panlungsod for an implementing resolution.

Section 6. Implementation. - The Bacolod City Song shall be taught to, and sung in, every public school in the City of Bacolod as well as local agencies/departments of the Bacolod City Government the singing of which shall be after the Philippine National Song during the Flag Raising Ceremony and other official affairs thereof.

Section 7. Effectivity. - This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its approval.
