CITY ORDINANCE NO. 223  
September 24, 1998

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE VIA ROUTE OF ALIJIS-LIBERTAD FRANCHISE AND INTEGRATING THIS ORDINANCE AS PART OF THE INTEGRATED TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT SYSTEM OF THE CITY OF BACOLOD UPON APPROVAL OF THE LATTER.

WHEREAS, LTFRB issued a new franchise namely Alijis-Libertad as requested by the Traffic Management Council in March, 1997 as a result of a Road Measurement Capacity (RMC) Test conducted in the city relative to the Alijis-Central Market route:

WHEREAS, there is the absence of an appropriate via route of this new franchise to guide PUJ owners and drivers on what specific road network they need to talk from the original point of origin to point of destination and vice-versa:

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Sangguniang Panlungsod, that in response to the urgent need to resolve this primary defect in the issuance of said franchise, the following are proposed:

**SECTION 1 - TITLE** - This Ordinance shall be called the via route of the Alijis-Libertad Franchise.

**SECTION 2 - POLICY** - It shall be the policy of the City to create and maintain a traffic environment that shall be orderly, free from congestion and conducive to smooth flow of vehicles and pedestrians for public welfare.

**SECTION 3 - VIA ROUTES** - The Alijis-Libertad route is a franchise issued by LTFRB allowing 40 units plying such routes.

To provide flexibility to the said PUJ's the following three (3) via routes are established:

1. From Alijis road turn right to Araneta Street, right to Magsaysay Avenue left to Lacson Street, right to Lizares ad left to Amelia Avenue, left to Libertad, left to Mabini Street towards their terminal at Mercedes Avenue;

2. From Alijis road to Araneta Street, right turn to Lizares Avenue all the way to Amelia Avenue to their terminal at Mercedes Avenue;

3. From Alijis road to Araneta Street, right turn to Libertad Street all the way to Libertad Market to end at their terminal at Mercedes Avenue;

**SECTION 4 - INTEGRATION OF THIS ORDINANCE WITH THE INTEGRATED TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT SYSTEM OF THE CITY OF BACOLOD** - This Ordinance shall be part of the Integrated Traffic Management System of the City of bacolod upon approval of the latter.

**SECTION 5 - PENALTY** - The current administrative penalty on "Out of Route" shall be imposed upon any driver of said franchise who shall commit said violation. Referral shall be City Ordinance No. 62, Series of 1989.

The amount collected shall be paid to the City Treasurer upon the issuance of MTOP and shall form part of the City General Fund.

**SECTION 6 - EFFECTIVITY** - This Ordinance shall become effective (fifteen) (15) days from its publication in a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Bacolod.


