RESOLUTION MOST RESPECTFULLY REQUESTING THE CITY MAYOR, HON. ALFREDO ABELARDO B. BENITEZ, TO CONVENE THE THANKSGIVING DAY COMMITTEE PURSUANT TO C.O. 09-17-819 OF MAY 24, 2017, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS "THE THANKSGIVING DAY ORDINANCE OF BACOLOD CITY".

Upon motion of Councilor Jason Isidro S. Villarosa, jointly seconded by Councilors Simplicia Z. Distrito and Al Victor A. Espino, the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Bacolod

RESOLVED, to pass the following resolution:

WHEREAS, on May 24, 2017, City Ordinance No. 09-17-819 was passed entitled: "AN ORDINANCE DECLARING THE FOURTH THURSDAY OF NOVEMBER OF EACH YEAR AS A DAY OF THANKSGIVING IN THE CITY OF BACOLOD AND PROVIDING FUNDS FOR ITS CELEBRATION";

WHEREAS, the City of Bacolod, since it became a Chartered City in 1938, has become a progressive and fast-developing highly urbanized city in the Philippines even in the midst of several crisis, natural calamities, and disasters;

WHEREAS, in light of such circumstances, the pertinent Ordinance states that the celebration of the Thanksgiving Day be set on every 4th Thursday of the month of November, in our case, on November 24, 2022;

WHEREAS, under Sec. 3, 2nd par., of the Thanksgiving Ordinance expressly states that the City Mayor shall create a Committee composed of government, private, and religious sectors of the City of Bacolod to prepare and organize the celebration of Thanksgiving Day.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to most respectfully request The City Mayor, Hon. Alfredo Abelardo B. Benitez, To Convene The Thanksgiving day committee pursuant to C.O. 09-17-819 of May 24, 2017, otherwise known as "The Thanksgiving Day Ordinance of Bacolod City".


