RESOLUTION NO. 1143 Series of 2022

RESOLUTION RESPECTFULLY REQUESTING THE HONORABLE BACOLOD CITY MAYOR ALFREDO ABELARDO B. BENITEZ THROUGH THE BACOLOD CITY HEALTH OFFICE, TO LAUNCH INTENSIFIED INFORMATION DISSEMINATION CAMPAIGN ON THE HEALTH RISK AND PREVENTION OF CHIKUNGUNYA DISEASE.

Upon motion of Councilor Claudio Jesus Raymundo A. Puentevella, jointly seconded by Councilors Celia Matea Matea R. Flor and Simplicia Z. Distrito, the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Bacolod

RESOLVED, to pass the following resolution:

WHEREAS, Section 15, Article II of the 1987 Philippine Constitution mandates the protection and promotion of the right to health of the people and instill health consciousness among them;

WHEREAS, Section 16 of Republic Act 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991 mandates the Local Government Units to exercise their power which are essential to the promotion of general welfare of the people;



WHEREAS, Chikungunya fever is an illness caused by a virus spread by mosquitoes. The name means "bends you up" or "stooped walk" because the infection causes severe joint and muscle pain. Other symptoms include sudden high fever, headache, fatigue, rash, nausea and red eyes. Symptoms of chikungunya often appear within 2 to 7 days after a bite from an infected mosquito;

WHEREAS, last November 28, 2022, The Department of Health issued a Chikungunya advisory that the Country logged a total of 551 cases of the said disease and a 589% higher case load compared last year (2021);

WHEREAS, through proper information dissemination drive, the spread of chikungunya disease can be prevented in the City of Bacolod and to inform also the public of the risk imposed by the disease to their health and well-being.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to respectfully request the Honorable Bacolod City Mayor Alfredo Abelardo B. Benitez through the Bacolod City Health Office, to launch intensified information dissemination campaign on the health risk and prevention of Chikungunya Disease.
