**RESOLUTION NO. 1206
Series of 2022**

RESOLUTION RESPECTFULLY REQUESTING THE BACOLOD CITY POLICE OFFICE THROUGH POLICE COLONEL THOMAS JOSEPH MARTIR TO INCREASE POLICE VISIBILITY IN AREAS MOST FREQUENTED BY PEOPLE AT NIGHT SUCH AS THE BAYWALK, THE BACOLOD PUBLIC PLAZA, THE BACOLOD CITY GOVERNMENT CENTER GROUNDS, YOYO LAND AND THE PROVINCIAL CAPITOL LAGOON TO ENSURE A SAFE, SECURE AND PEACEFUL CELEBRATION OF CHRISTMAS AND NEW YEAR IN BACOLOD CITY.

Upon motion of Councilor Em L. Ang, jointly seconded by Councilors Jude Thaddeus A. Sayson, Simplicia Z. Distrito, Jason Isidro S. Villarosa and Celia Matea R. Flor, the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Bacolod

RESOLVED to pass the following resolution:

WHEREAS, Section 5, Article II of the 1987 Philippine Constitution provides that, "The maintenance of peace and order, the protection of life, liberty, and property, and promotion of the general welfare are essential for the enjoyment by all the people of the blessings of democracy";




WHEREAS, Section 16 of Republic Act No. 7160 otherwise known as the Local Government Code provides that, "Every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied there from, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare";

WHEREAS, the Christmas and New Year's Day holiday seasons are the time of the year that the above-mentioned places are frequented by most people because of the opulent, colorful decorations and abundant bright lights in their respective areas;

WHEREAS, statistics show that where there are many people gathered in an area especially at night time, criminal activities often occur;

WHEREAS, to maintain security, peace and order in the aforesaid frequented areas and to ensure the safety of the people visiting the same, it is necessary for police visibility to be increased in the said areas;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to respectfully request the Bacolod City Police Office through Police Colonel Thomas Joseph Martir to increase police visibility in areas most frequented by people at night such as the Baywalk, the Bacolod Public Plaza, the Bacolod City Government Center Grounds, Yoyo Land and the Provincial Capitol Lagoon to ensure a safe, secure and peaceful celebration of Christmas and New Year in Bacolod City.


