Accordingly, we are presenting this Citizen's Charter that will help constituents track the progress of their transactions with the City Government and ultimately hold us accountable for our actions or lack thereof.

The Citizen's Charter is a platform that brings the City Government closer to the People, as it embodies our objective of strengthening public trust and confidence in Government. Through this Citizen's Charter, we hope to build a strong relationship with residents, visitors and investors as we promote inclusive, sustainable and resilient development in Bacolod City.

Join us in this journey of transforming Bacolod into a Super City, a model city for effective local governance, distinguished for its efficiency, economic diversity, and commitment to environmental sustainability and social justice.
