RESOLUTION RESPECTFULLY REQUESTING THE BACOLOD ENVIRONMENT NATURAL RESOURCES OFFICE (BENRO) THROUGH THE OFFICE OF THE HONORABLE CITY MAYOR ALFREDO ABELARDO B. BENITEZ TO REQUIRE ALL PRIVATE COMPANIES WITHIN THE CITY OF BACOLOD TO ESTABLISH A GARBAGE STORAGE FACILITY/ EQUIPMENT IN ACCORDANCE WITH CITY ORDINANCE NO. 250 SERIES OF 2000.

Upon motion of Councilor Claudio Jesus Raymundo A. Puentevella, jointly seconded by Councilors Em L. Ang, Jason Isidro S. Villarosa and Simplicia Z. Distrito, the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Bacolod

RESOLVED, to pass the following resolution:

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 9003 also known as the Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2000 was passed into law last January 26, 2000;

WHEREAS, Article 2, Section 22 (b) of RA 9003 provides the establishment of solid waste container which shall be properly marked for on-site collection as compostable, non-recyclable, recyclable, and special waste;

WHEREAS, City Ordinance No. 250 Series of 2000, Section 5 thereof provides that all households, occupants, owners or operators of industrial, commercial, or business establishment shall provide their own garbage or waste containers or receptacles for purposes of garbage disposal and sanitation.

WHEREAS, the proper storage of Municipal Solid Waste (MSW) is the primary responsibility of every individual, owners or operators of industrial and commercial establishments before its scheduled collection by the city or authorized private collectors;

WHEREAS, the establishment of a garbage storage facility/equipment is needed for the successful implementation of segregation at source in the community level.

NOW THEREFOR, BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to respectfully request the Bacolod Environment Natural Resources Office (BENRO) through the Office of the Honorable City Mayor Alfredo Abelardo B. Benitez to require all private companies within the City of Bacolod to establish a garbage storage facility/equipment in accordance with City Ordinance No. 250, Series of 2000.
