RESOLUTION NO. 1105 Series of 2023

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE BACOLOD PERMITS AND LICENSING OFFICE (BPLO), BUREAU OF FIRE PROTECTION (BFP), BACOLOD CITY TRAFFIC AUTHORITY OFFICE (BTAO), AND THE CITY LEGAL OFFICE ENFORCEMENT UNIT, FOR THE STRICT ENFORCEMENT, IMPLEMENTATION AND MONITORING OF CITY ORDINANCE NO. 885 PROHIBITING THE REFILLING, DISTRIBUTION AND RETAILING OF LIQUEFIED PETROLEUM GAS (LPG)-FILLED BUTANE CANISTERS WITHIN THE TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION OF THE CITY OF BACOLOD.

Upon motion of Councilor Em L. Ang, seconded by Councilor Cindy T. Rojas, the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Bacolod

RESOLVED, to pass the following resolution:

WHEREAS, Section 5 of C.O.885 otherwise known as the "Anti-LPG-Refilled Canisters of Butane Ordinance", prohibits the following:

- a. To refill LPG into a canister, previously filled with butane or not registered or approved by the Bureau of Philippine Standards.
- b. To distribute and transport, by any means of transportation, any LPG in canister, or from a known refiller of LPG into canister, previously filled with butane or not registered or approved by the Bureau of Philippine Standards, to any customer;
- c. To retail LPG in canister previously filled with butane or in canister not approved by the Bureau of Philippine Standards;

WHEREAS, there are several recent fire incidents in different barangays of the city which are reported to be caused by leakage of butane canisters;

WHEREAS, the strict implementation of the above-mentioned provisions of the Ordinance will significantly reduce fire hazards and therefore prevent potential fires in the city;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to request the Bacolod Permits and Licensing Office (BPLO), Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP), Bacolod City Traffic Authority Office (BTAO) and the City Legal Office Enforcement Unit, for the strict enforcement, implementation and monitoring of City Ordinance No. 885 prohibiting the refilling, distribution and retailing of Liquefied Petroleum Gas (LPG) filled butane canisters within the territorial jurisdiction of the City of Bacolod.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, that a copy of this Resolution be immediately furnished to the the offices of the Bacolod Permits and Licensing Office (BPLO), Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP), Bacolod City Traffic Authority Office (BTAO) and the City Legal Office Enforcement Unit.
